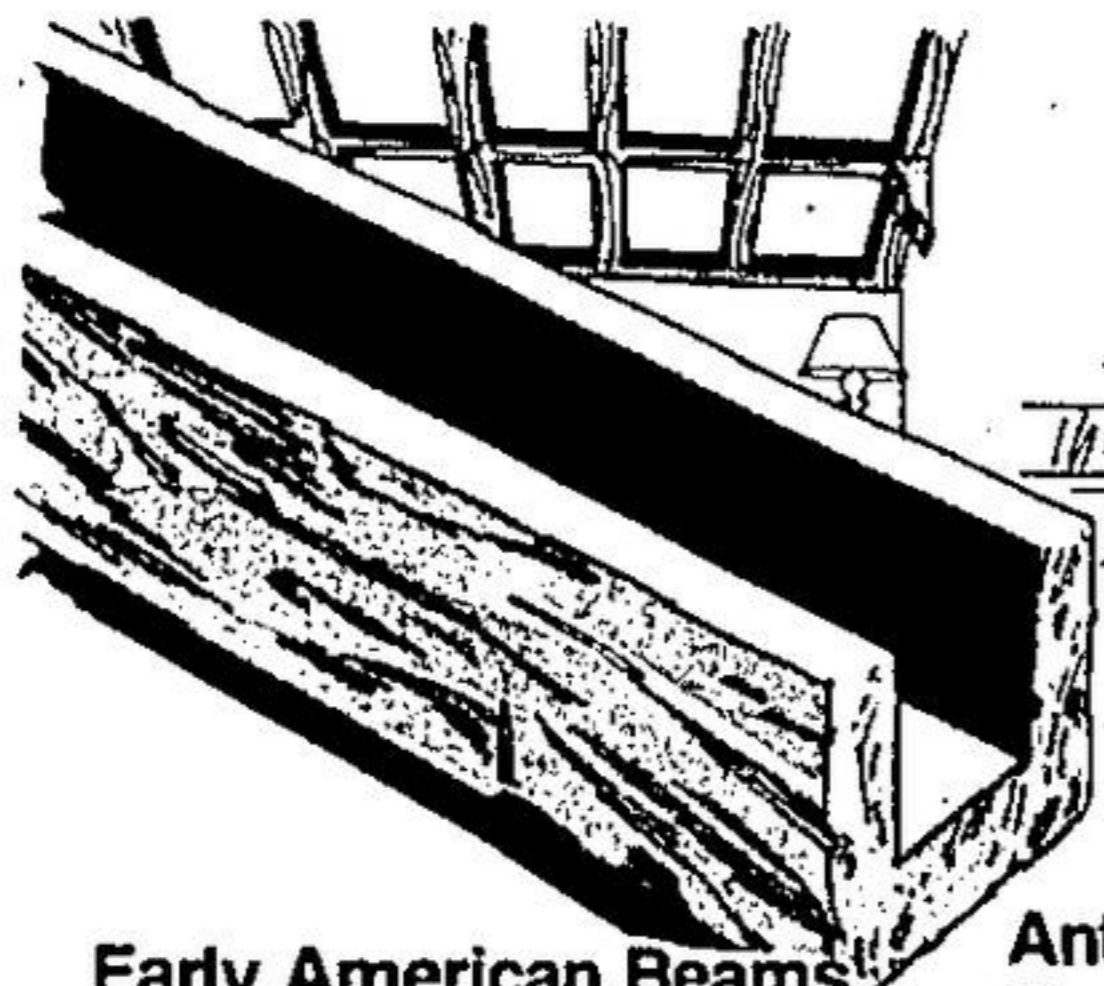
Wingrove hosts 4-H Dairy club
