149 object to plan

Over 140 landowners in the former township of Esquesing have filed objections with the Ontario Municipal Board about various sections of the Comprehensive Zoning Bylaw for the former township of Esquesing.

Hutton Hills town planner

Mario Venditti told the town's subsidiary planning board last week that of the 149 objections filed thus far two have already been dealt with by the planning department and another 50 will likely not present a problem for the OMB to deal with.

"Either the people won't

come out for the hearings, or the board will shove them back into the desk because there's no real case."

That leaves, however, 97 objections to be heard by the OMB when it begins its hearings on the important bylaw this fall. Mr. Venditti

predicted that the hearings will begin within two months. The town is beginning now to prepare for the legal wranglings that will take place before the OMB. The planning board has designated the town's solicitors and M. M. Dillon to act on its behalf.

Persons with either O-Positive or A-Positive blood are asked to donate. Eight

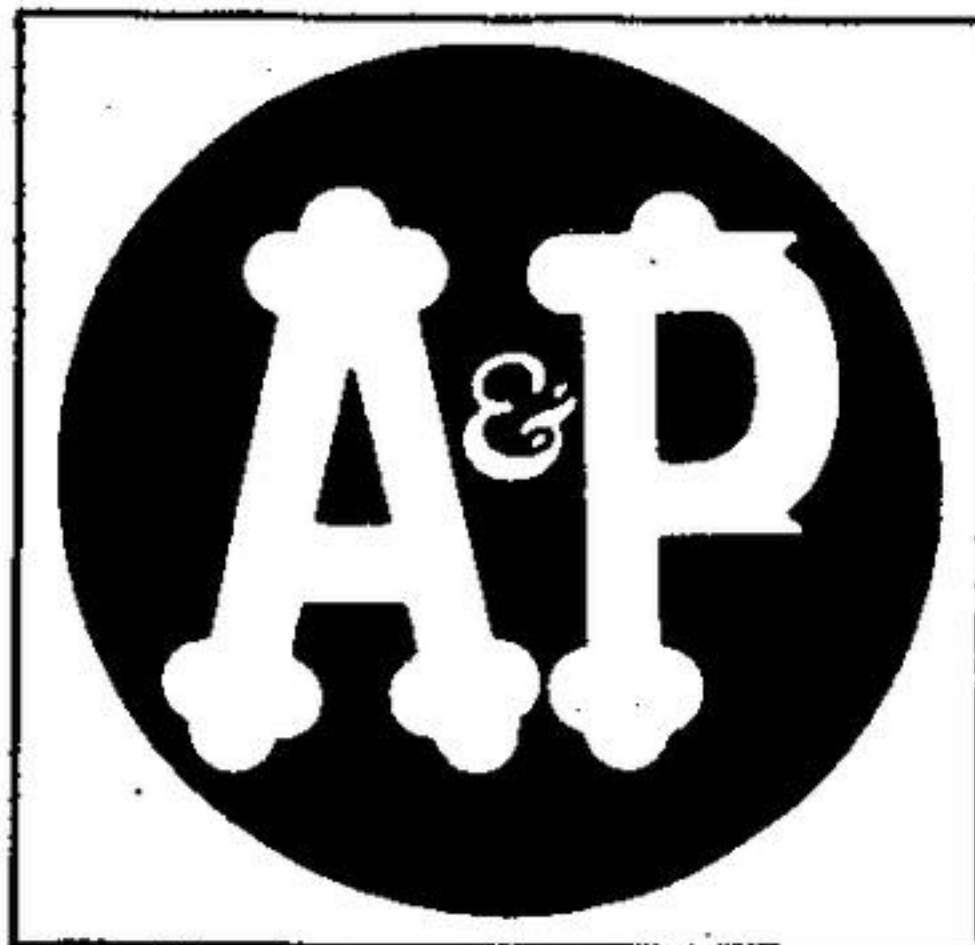
units of each of those types are needed for heart operations on September 9 in Toronto General Hospital.
