Two false alarms, one at the Georgetown and District High School and one at Georgetown and District Memorial Hospital were attended to by fire officials over the weekend.

A barn fire of Jim Brown completely destroyed the storage barn on his property located on the 4th Line south of 25 Sideroad. The alarm was called in at 4:10 with the blaze destroying the barn before firefighters arrived on the scene.
