**Burglars break into Joseph Gibbons**

Halton Regional Police of District One were kept busy investigating the many thefts and cases of break and entry recorded this past week.

Last Monday night or early Tuesday morning thieves entered Joseph Gibbons Public School through a south window of the Moore Park Crescent School. The thieves netted for themselves two portable tape recorders and accessories which are identified with special markings.

Four large garbage cans valued at over \$300 each were removed from a Moore Park Plaza business the same night as the school break-in. The cans were sitting outside the owner's place of business. Gasoline thieves removed an undetermined amount of the valuable liquid from a car

parked in front of the Travelways office on Mountlview. A man's gold pocket watch, ladies wallet and a carving knife were noticed missing following a report to police of illegal entry through a basement window of a Byron Street home.

Damage to a parked car in the Go station was noted. The owner has yet to advise police if anything was removed from the parked car. The operator of a Charterways bus parked at George Kennedy School reported to police last week that the vehicle had been the victim of willful damage. Windshield wipers were damaged and distributor wires removed from the engine compartment.

The parked car of a Pennington Crescent resident is minus several items left by the owner. Two sleeping bags, a coat, one citizen's Band antenna, one sports jacket and one pair of bowling shoes were taken in the Wednesday theft. A chrome-plated gas cap was reported missing by the owner of an imported car while parked at a local service station. Parking authority signs were uprooted from the ground in the industrial section of town last Friday by unknown persons. The group also are suspected of lowering the dolly wheels of a trailer parked at a factory along Todd Road. Georgetown may have faster, more frequent Toronto and return bus service by Jan. 4, 1976.  
Tom Henry, information officer of the Toronto Area Transit Authority, said diesel buses may run half-hourly during the rush hour and hourly during the off peak time.  
No schedules or fares have been set so far, said Mr. Henry, although the run was expected to begin by the middle of this month.  
The buses will travel east on Hwy. 7 south on Mississauga Rd. east on Queen St. in Brampton, loop into the Bramalea City Centre to meet dial-a-buses, continue south on Bramalea Rd. east on Steeles Ave., south on Airport Rd., through the four corners of Mallon, to the airport expressway, east on the 401 to Weston Rd. and east on Wilson Ave. to the York Mills subway station.
