**New  
kennel  
bylaw  
on way**

A new kennel licensing bylaw for Halton Hills will be presented to town council at its next meeting. Although it will not grossly affect present kennels operating in the town, the new kennel bylaw will have a great affect upon any operators hoping to start new ones within Halton Hills. The town's personnel and finance committee reviewed the new bylaw at its meeting Monday night. It encompasses sections of both the town's old bylaws and new kennel regulations recently adopted by the town of Fergus. Grant Usher, the town's assistant treasurer, explained to the committee that the new bylaw, if passed, would allow town staff to regulate both old and new kennels. At present, he commented, they have been withholding action on approximately five kennel applications pending the drawing up of a new bylaw. The only affect the bylaw will have on the kennels already in operations would be to require that they continue to meet the approval of the region's medical officers. New kennels, however, will have to meet a certain minimum square footage. The Fergus bylaw states a minimum of 19,000 square feet. The bylaw also restricts kennel operations in urban areas. A suggestion that a limit be placed on the number of dogs individuals not operating kennels could own did not receive support from the committee members. Limiting people to only two or three dogs, commented clerk-administrator Doug Pritchard, would "be playing with a bombshell." Oakville, commented Mr. Usher, controlled that by charging a large tag fee for any more than two dogs owned by an individual. The first tag would cost \$7, the second, \$15, the third \$30 and so on. No action, however, was recommended.

An extension to the existing water pollution control plant  
incorporating an influent works; a raw sewage pumping  
station; a grit remover (detritor); two primary clarifiers;  
two aeration tanks; two secondary clarifiers with an ac-  
tivated sludge pumping station; a building complex  
housing two tertiary sand filters; a diesel generator and a  
substation with low and high voltage switch gear; a  
chlorine contact chamber; modifications to existing office  
building and sewage treatment units; a chemical storage  
tank and pump room; a boiler room; the process and yard  
piping; site grading; asphalt roads; miscellaneous
