

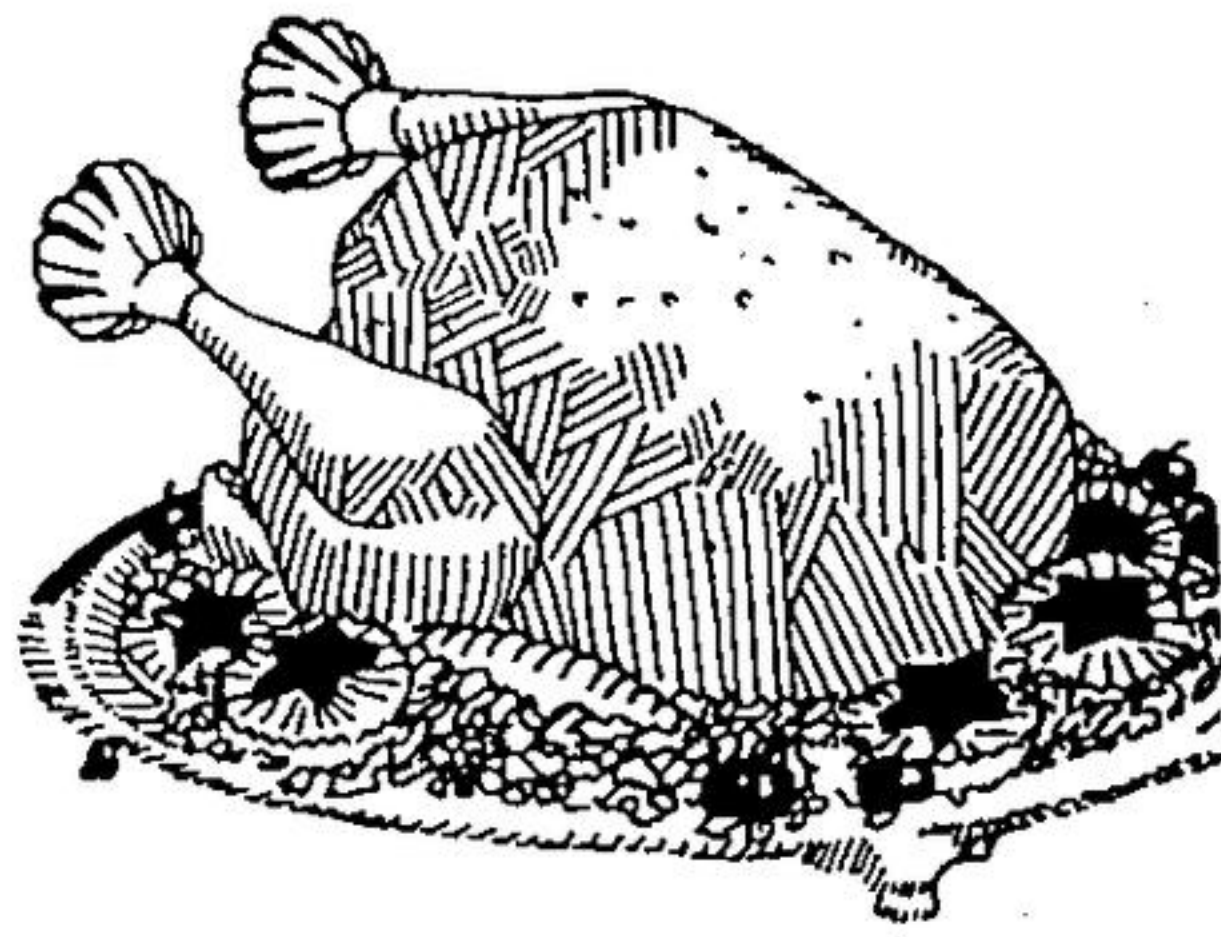

**GO now schedules buses to start Jan. 4**

Delays in production of 12 new GO buses have delayed the start of the northwest GO commuter bus service to Georgetown and Brampton. The service, which will provide additional commuter service to the present rush hour GO train systems was expected to start in November but GO officials explain that production delays at the General Motors production plant in London, Ontario have resulted in a tentative commencement of services January 4. The buses will provide daily service between Georgetown and the York Mills subway station on Yonge Street via Brampton, Bramalea, and Malton.

**October Crisis film at library**

"The October Crisis" will be the subject of an hour and a half movie to be shown this Friday, December 19, in the downstairs junior library of the Georgetown Public Library. The film "Action: The October Crisis of 1970" was directed by Robin Spry. Compiled from news and other actuality film, it shows independence movements past and present, and their leaders; it reflects the mingled relief, dismay and defiance when the Canadian army came to Montreal and it shows how political leaders viewed the intervention. On February 20 a sequel, Reaction: A Portrait of a Society in Crisis will be presented by the library. Friday's screening will start at 7:30.

**Artisans programs still open**
