L'Arche plan dance

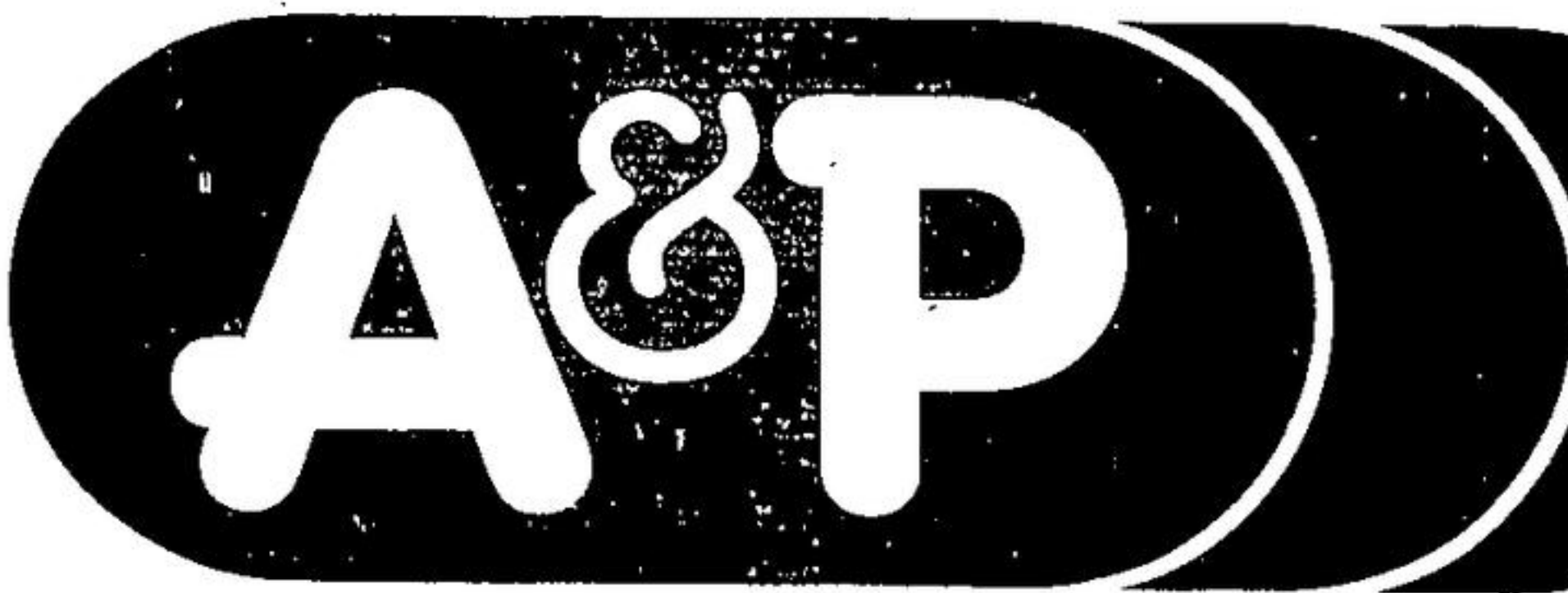
The L'Arche Auxiliary held their monthly meeting on February 24 at the home of Mrs. C. Steen.
