

Combines Act Creates Woes For Industry

Abolition of fixed commissions by real estate board eliminated one of the major hazards to the real estate industry created by the Combines Investigation Act, but there are others.

The federal legislation, which was recently amended by Bill C-2, to include all service industries, began applying to the real estate industry, for all practical purposes as of Jan. 1. In an-ticipation of the passage of the Bill, which finally occurred last December, real estate boards over the past 18 months have been removing any reference to a mandatory schedule of fees, tariffs and commissions.

An amendment to the Bill, negotiated in Ottawa by the Canadian Real Estate Association also ensured the continuance of the operation of the Multiple Listing Service by boards. The original draft legislation could have prohibited the present MLS operations across Canada as being restrictive and monopolistic, and therefore illegal, with heavy fines or jail terms being the result of a successful prosecution by the Department of Consumer and Corporate Affairs.

Despite these achievements, there are other possible applications of this heavily consumeroriented legislation to the traditional methods of real estate brokerage, which could cause problems

The most obvious and pressing is the application of Section 37 of the Act, as outlined on page 11 of this

As President John Boyd pointed out: "The ridiculous aspect of the application of this Section is that it is counter-productive to the current aims of the government. The only sure way to avoid the possibility of a sale above the listed or advertised price is to list well above the current market value. Ultimately this practice could induce an upward movement in market prices, resulting in higher housing prices when the government is trying to restrain cost and price increases."

Despite the abandonment of fixed commissions by the real estate board, the prohibition against "price fixing" as defined in the Act will still apply to real estate. Members are warned that the possibility of criminal charges would exist where even two or more real estate brokers agreed to maintain the same commission rates. A standardized tariff schedule within a single company is not a violation of the Act.

Misleading advertising is another feature of the Act, primarily conceived to apply to the manufacturing and marketing segments of the economy, which could cause future complications.

CREA is attempting, through a series of meetings with federal Consumer and Corporate Attairs officials, to establish a series of understandings and guidelines under which boards and members could work with minimum exposure to the possibility of charges brought under the amended Act by either consumers or the Depart-
