

## Town, residents must share costs of Metcalfe clean-up

After a 45-minute in camera session Monday night attended by the town solicitor, Ray Steele, and the building inspector, Doug Sargent, the works committee revealed that the solicitor will be sending to the residents of

Metcalfe Court a letter advising them that they, the residents, will be responsible for the upper portion of the ravine and the town will be responsible for the lower portion.

## No one is being evicted, trailer park owner states

John Prueyk, owner and operator of Waterfalls Park and Lodge near Limehouse, said in an interview that he is not evicting the 12 tenants presently occupying mobile homes on his property.

"I don't know where they are getting their information," he said in referring to reports in the press that tenants will be evicted. "As far as I know, no one is being evicted."

As for plans by the township to reforest

his 153 acres which he has had since 1954, "they better ask me first," he said.

As to reports that an application to the Ontario Municipal Board had been withdrawn, Mr. Prueyk said the report had never been withdrawn "to my knowledge."

He said that he made a verbal agreement over the phone with the town's solicitor not to take any new tenants but was not evicting anyone from his property. He plans to get in touch with his solicitors, he added.

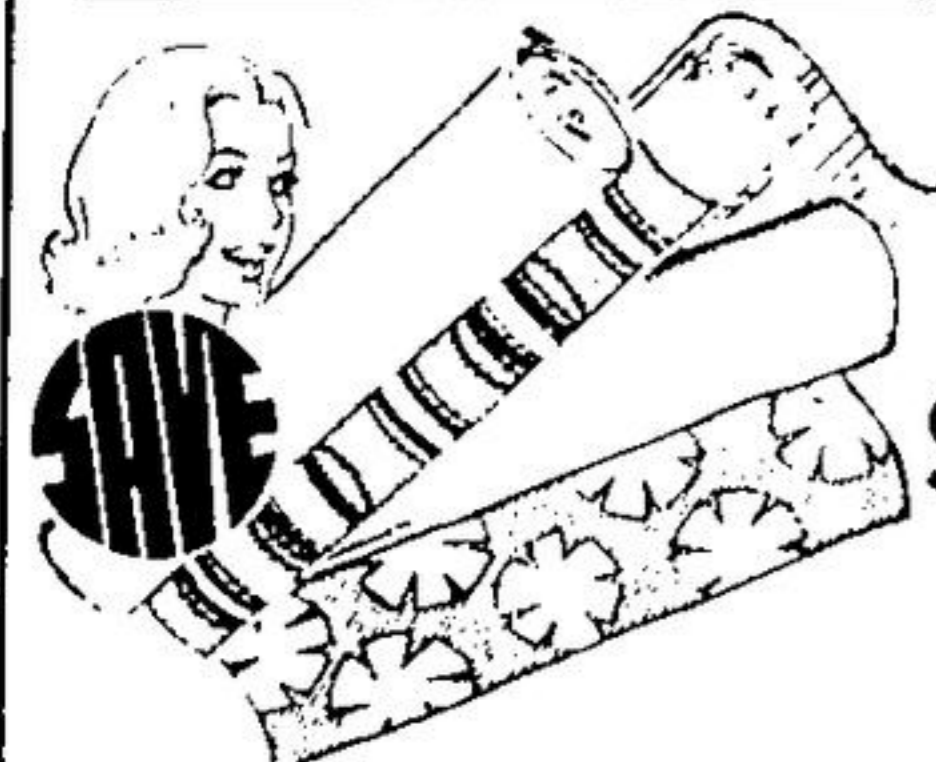
