Community Services want to meet you

After getting a home base two months ago in the Murray Memorial "Y" building, the Acton Community Services Centre has begun moving out into the town.

Judy McLin, co-ordinator at the centre, told the Herald in an interview that she has begun taking the centre's message out to the community by means of speaking engagements.

"The whole concept is so open, it can go anywhere the community wants it to go," she said, referring to the two-month-old centre.

"Mostly everyone accepts it but the biggest problem is they don't understand what we do." That's why she has begun the speaking engagements, she said. Not only will she be spreading the word of what the centre can offer to the community but she'll find out what the community wants. "We would appreciate more input," she said.

Acceptance of the centre's facilities by professionals in social work "has been good",

she said, adding, "It will pick up. We've only been here a couple of months."

She said the centre was starting up an odd job market for teenagers willing to work for a day or two cutting lawns, cleaning up yards, painting and what not.

Also, she added, people who were willing to do day care were needed.

Judy could not turn down an opportunity to say that the Children's Aid "desperately needed a driver" in the area. The work involves driving children from one foster home to another or taking parents to visit their children who are in distant foster homes. Volunteer drivers get mileage expenses, she said. There will be a meeting today (Wednesday) at 7:30 p.m. in the centre for people wishing to become volunteers.

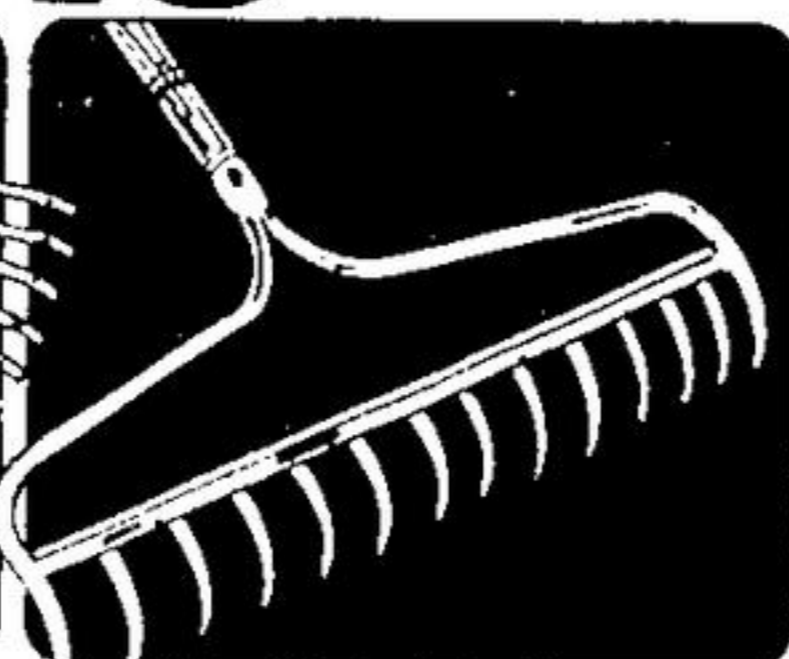
