Everything from the refrigerators to the lockers to the pro shop have had something either replaced or rebuilt at an approximate cost of \$355,000.

Visitors to the golf and country club received a behind-the-scenes view of the new renovations over the weekend. The tour starts, appropriately enough, at the heart of the entire building, the new offices of the club's manager, Marian Faulkner.

From there you move on to a new innovation and one which has already met with busy acceptance from local businessmen: a new boardroom available for rent for small meetings or luncheons.

After that it's a few short steps to an area of the building that promises to be a key point in Halton Hills' social life, a quiet cocktail lounge and stand-up bar. Always an integral part of any country

club, North Halton's lounge certainly surpasses the normal standards with its comfortable new captains chairs, low lights and plush carpeting.

Fred Long was on hand

during the tour to point out that social memberships to the club are available for \$60 per month.

After a game of golf, curling or tennis there's nothing better than a hot lunch. During a normal business day there's nothing nicer than a good dinner. For both those needs North Halton's kitchen staff, under chefs Dwight Forth and Bob Miko, are ready and raring to satisfy with a full menu of well prepared meals from the ultra-modern kitchen.

The only thing that seems to have been saved from the old kitchen was... not the kitchen sink—but the old stove.

The dining area is large and bright, overlooking the scenic ponds located immediately to the north of the club house. Lena Bidwell is the hostess of the dining room.

If it's fresh air you prefer then the patio deck has been enlarged and covered over. A nice place to sit and chat after a gruelling nine holes of golf prior to heading out the back nine.

The indoor lounge that becomes home for many a curler during the winter months has been enlarged with the removal of the corner bar. Also all the furniture is in for a facelift thanks to recovering.

Downstairs the changes are even more startling. The major addition is a new banquet room that's available for wedding receptions, special events and service clubs. You don't have to be a member, by the way, to rent the facilities.

Ladies washrooms have been renovated complete with a new sauna.

The men's lockers have

been given a brightening up plus having been enlarged.

Golf pro Don Fendley and his assistant John Henderson are enjoying the comforts of new facilities in their totally renovated pro shop that overlooks a new feature entirely of the club, the tennis courts. A new world is opening up for club members who wish to take out tennis memberships. Thus far there's plenty of open time on the courts.

If you come in off the front nine and don't particularly want to spend too much time in the club before heading out again there's now a snack bar right on your path from one hole to the next.

All in all, the focal point at North Halton these days is switching from the outdoors to the indoors facilities.
