The separate appraisals were ordered following disclosure in the Burlington Post three weeks ago that the land in question was purchsed by the Hamilton Harbor Commission about 10 years ago from the province for about \$42,000.

The Post at that time reported the harbor commission sought \$218,000 for the property which surrounds the pollution control plant.

Approval of the purchase was given in a short incamera meeting last week despite a reported regional appraisal of \$100,000 for the property.
