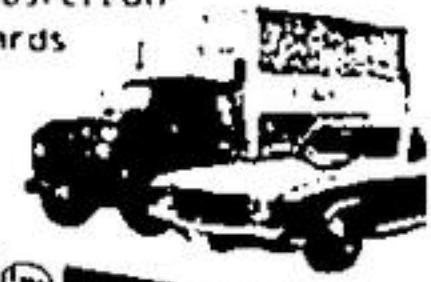
**OMB approves limit**

"I think Darcy McKeough should be made aware of our austerity program and that we saved \$1.1 million like he asked us to in the first place," finance committee chairman Coun. Ernie Sykes said, commenting on the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board of the expenditure for capital projects in Halton Hills. The approval is a formality based on the proposed yearly capital budget and the financial ability of the municipality to absorb the debt, administrator Doug Pritchard said.
