Ernie Sykes said, commenting on the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board of the expenditure for capital projects in Halton Hills. The approval is a formality based on the proposed yearly capital budget and the financial ability of the municipality to absorb the debt, administrator Doug Pritchard said.
