Planning committee deletes condition

Regional planning committee last week deleted one of the conditions Mountclair Developments, which is building a subdivision on Regional Road 17 immediately north of Georgetown in the former Township of Esquimes near Meadowlark Mushrooms Ltd. Lawyer Terrence representing Meadowlark Mushrooms Ltd. appeared before the committee to say the firm agrees with all but one of the 16 conditions. The firm objects to a condition that would limit the extension of uses of building on abutting lands.

The condition is included in planning director Ed Cumming's recommendation to approve the subdivision in order to keep composting activities at the mushroom farm away from the proposed homes and thus alleviate odor and pest complaints.
