Haltion Region will maintain its offices in Burlington for at least another 18 months; possibly 24 months.

Council has approved the setting of new rental rates for the lease of the Abbey Life Building offices on Harvester Road at \$11,255 per month with a cash advance of \$31,000.

Monthly rent ending this year is \$11,300 and was preceded by a \$100,000 cash payment.
