Varian wins defense contract

A \$100,035 U.S. Government contract has been awarded Canadian Commercial Corporation, Ottawa, Ontario, Canada by the U.S. Defense Supply Agency's Defense Electronics Supply Centre, Dayton, Ohio.

A fixed-price, supply-type award, the contract provides for manufacture of 721 klystron electron tubes for delivery to the Centre during the next six months. Varian Associates of Canada, Ltd. Georgetown, Ontario will manufacture the tubes.

The Defense Electronics Supply Center procures, manages and supplies common electronic parts used by the armed services and various other government agencies.
