GLT prepares finale

Georgetown Little Theatre's final production of the season - No Sex Please - We're British - is a play for mature or adult audiences, says Pat Joyes, director of publicity.

"Children won't understand or enjoy it," she says, but adds that her own 13-year-old daughter will be seeing the comedy because members of the family are in it.

First produced in England in 1971, the play written by Anthony Marriott and Alistair Foot is about the difficulties faced by a newly married couple when instead of a shipment of glassware that had been ordered packages of dirty pictures arrive followed by blue movies, dozens of sex manuals and finally by two female troubleshooters from the company.

And as the material arrives the frantic couple try their frenzied best to keep knowledge of the pornographic matter from their family, the police and a bank inspector who eventually falls into the clutches of the trouble shooters.

GLT officials stress however that nothing pornographic ever comes on stage and audiences won't be offended. It's a play of humorous circumstances, says GLT president Bob Lee.

And as usual with the final production of the season, GLT has hired a professional to direct the work. He's Don Ford, a director of over 200 productions and resident art director of York Centennial Theatre. Ford directed the play's first performances in Canada and the current production of it is his fourth.

The play is not one of those in which the director must solve a basic problem to make the work come off, he says. It's only problem is the cast and he's impressed with the calibre of the GLT amateurs.

"It's not a young cast," he says. Most have been around about 30 years. He quickly amends that to ten years then goes on: "It means they're fairly well schooled."

Most of the cast have a lot of experience, he says, "and if well cast, anybody can be a director."

As a professional director working with an amateur troupe, Ford says he'll try to remove any "amateurishness."

However, he adds he doesn't look at such productions as amateur and he believes audiences don't either. "Usually the audience comes to enjoy itself."

The difference between professional actors and amateur actors is that while the pros get paid for their work, the amateurs do it for love of the theatre, he says.

The hiring of a professional director by GLT is made possible through a grant from Theatre Ontario.

The performance will open for a four-night run April 27 at Howard Wrigglesworth School. In the cast are Neville Worsnop, Yvonne Kathwaroon, Pat Joyes, Ron Hill, Ron Hunt, Bev Nicholas, Derek Joyes, Margaret Eggerton Nancy Waters and Stephen Bloom.
