### Founder of home for deaf awarded Order of Canada

The founder of a group home for the deaf in Georgetown, Rev. Robert L. Rumball has been appointed a member of the Order of Canada, Rev. Rumball is the Minister and Head of the Ontario Mission for the Deaf. Governor-General Jules Leger makes the formal award today in Ottawa.

For twenty years, Rev. Rumball has been the ears and the voice for many, in the home, the church, the courts, the hospitals or on the job.

A former football player for the Ottawa Roughriders and the Toronto Arges, he opened the first church to the deaf in Canada-the Ontario Mission of the Deal at the Evangelical Church in Toronto in 1956. There are now

congregations associated with

Rev. Rumball's ministry. He founded the Ontario Camp for the Deaf in Parry Sound in 1960, Ontario Group Homes for Deaf Youth in Toronto, 1970, in Woodbridge in 1973, in Georgetown in 1974,

and for adults in Toronto and He attended the University

of Toronto from 1948-1952 when he graduated with his Bachelor of Arts. He was honored by Victoria University with an honorary Doctor of Divinity in 1969 and in 1972 was chosen Man of the Year of the Canadian Association of the Deaf, he received the Lions International Humanitarian Award and awarded an honorary Doctor of Law from the University of Toronto.


A soup and sandwich luncheon, which attracted an estimated 75 people, was put on Friday by the ways and means committee of


