



Stop drilling

Halton Region council has taken no action on a letter from a lawyer for opponents of Site F as a landfill location who claims that any further testing and drilling at the location may be illegal.

David Esfrin, counsel for the Tremaine-Britannia Citizens Group has asked that no further drilling take place until a new council bylaw is passed. The previous bylaw, he said, passed by council authorizing such action, was overturned by the Ontario Supreme Court, April 19.

He also argued that any action to secure lands or options to purchase, whether written or verbal, could be illegal and his group is prepared to seek restraining orders if the region acts.

Council delayed action on the letter despite the objections of Burlington Mayor Harry Munro who demanded to know why the May 3 letter did not appear on the agenda of the meeting with a solicitor's report.

The letter was revealed publicly in the Burlington Gazette which obtained it for publication last week. All matters for legal consideration by council are held confidential.

Meanwhile council approved the public works committee investigating a proposal for Oakville Coun. Laurie Mannell to provide two sites in Oakville for regional landfill.

He called for "immediate steps to try to locate a temporary site or sites that can be used or a permanent site that can be used instead of site F," since the delay in approvals for the Tremaine-Britannia site is due to legal action.

Burlington Coun. Tom Sutherland termed the proposal "ludicrous" and would result in extensive studies for alternative sites similar to the more than \$250,000 studies which located Site F. It would also raise opposition and controversy at the alternative sites.
