Today's paper will be the last issue that Frank Mullin, the Herald's advertising salesman and Sales Manager for 12 years, helps to put out.

Tomorrow, Thursday, being his last day, none of the staff expect him to do much more than not say good bye but merely 'so long'. It's expected that he'll also be saying so long to some of the clients he has served in Georgetown.

Born in Fredericton, New Brunswick, in 1909, Frank didn't get started in selling newspaper space until after he had returned from a stint working for an uncle in a papermill in Springfield, Mass.

In those days newspapers did not have the advertising staffs they do now, and Frank got started with a small advertising agency doing the work for the Halifax-Chronicle-Star. When that paper amalgamated with another to form the Chronicle-Herald-Mail-Star, Frank moved to Ontario to work for the Owen Sound Sun-Times.

He joined the Thomson chain of newspapers in January, 1961, on the Pembroke Observer, moved to Brampton when The Times was then a weekly called the Conservator and finally to The Herald in Georgetown in 1965.

Bridge and horse racing are Frank's two hobbies. He has a cautious system of placing bets, merely to make the race more interesting, and it covers his expenses in going to the track. He figures he's a little ahead of the game.

The day after tomorrow, Canada Day, Frank will be enjoying his holiday and on Monday when his retirement begins in earnest, he plans to take a brief trip, probably back to New Brunswick where he has relatives that he has visited annually since coming to Ontario. But he'll return to stay in Georgetown which he considers his home. He has no particular plans for his retirement.

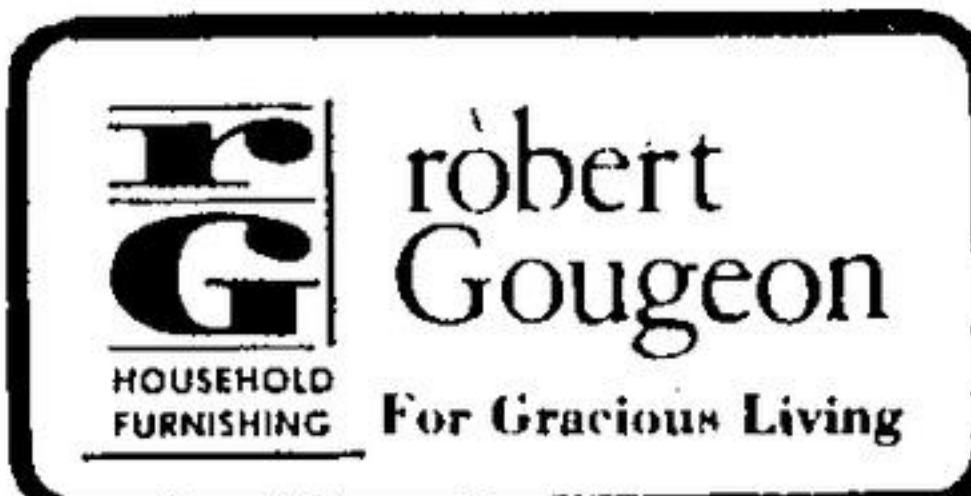

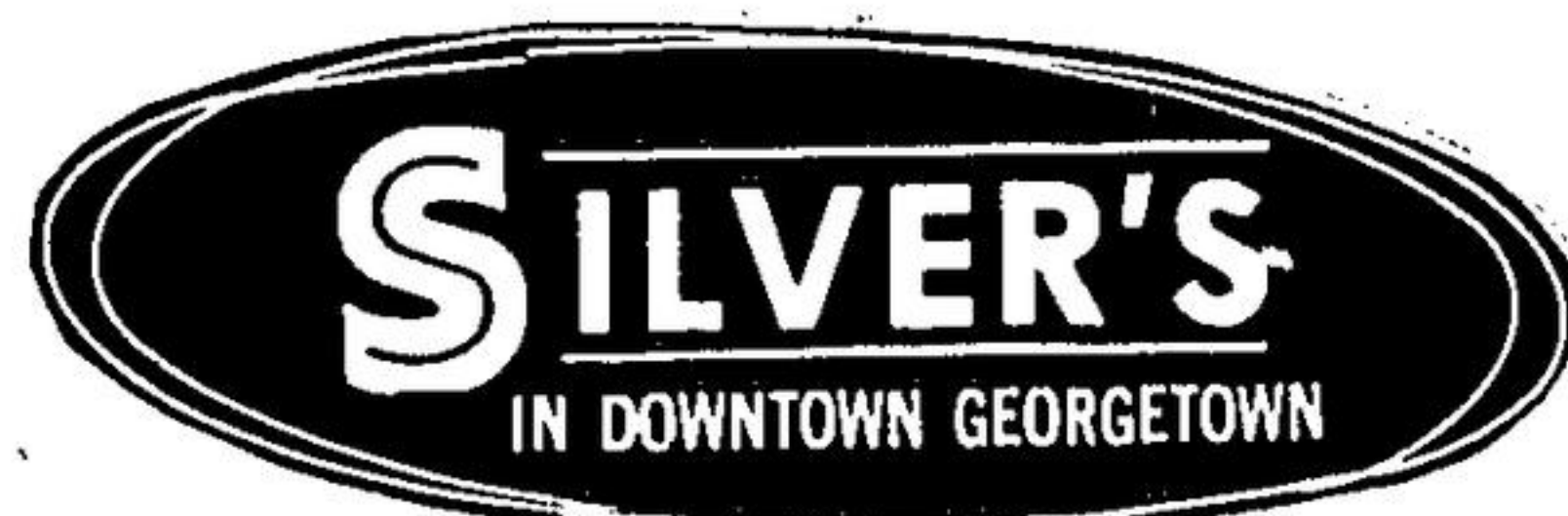
