

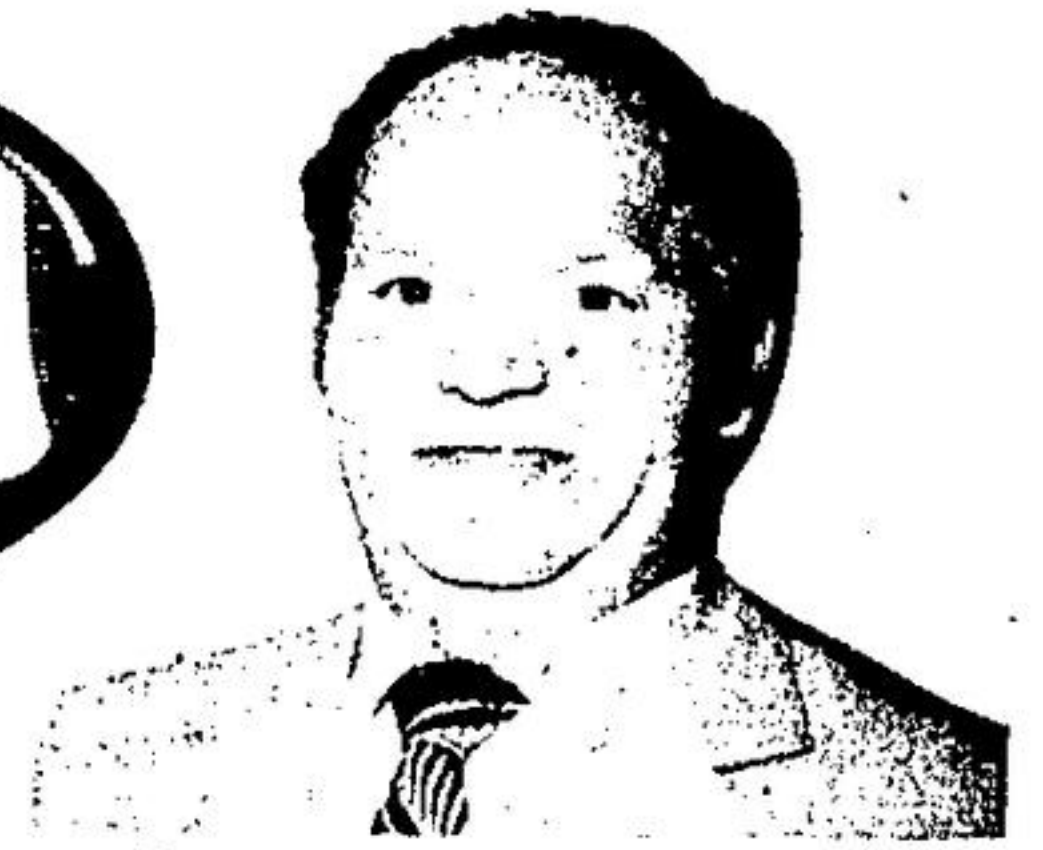

Freezing Potatoes

It's harvest time, so, for the economically minded, here are tips on how to store those extra potatoes. The usual method is to use cold storage at 45°F; although it should be kept in mind that raw potatoes neither store nor freeze well and are at their best when quickly boiled and buttered.

But do you want to try something new with the other varieties? Freeze them, as follows:

Raw whole potatoes (except new potatoes) - Cook until almost done and then freeze.

Mashed potatoes - Freeze as is, but these will only keep for a short time.

French fries - Either soak in cold water, blanch and then freeze; or soak in ice water, fry completely in fat, drain well and then freeze. These will last for about four months. New potatoes don't make great fries.

Baked potatoes - Bake completely, scoop out centre and mash with milk, butter and salt. Refill shells, cover with foil and freeze. Reheat in oven.
