REGISTRATION

Because some courses may be limited in size it is to your advantage to take a moment and advance register by MAIL to ensure a place in class. Please do not send cash in the mail. Official receipts will be processed and mailed to you as quickly as possible. For those who find it more convenient to register in person, or who have any questions regarding operation of Night School, there will be registration at Georgetown High School on Tuesday, September 13, 1977 from 7:30-9:00 p.m.

REFUNDS AND WITHDRAWALS

The Adult Education Department reserves the right to withdraw, postpone, or combine classes, and to limit registration or change instructors. Should insufficient enrolment cause the cancellation of a class, fees will be fully refunded, or the student may transfer to another course.

Five dollars of the fee for any course in which a class is opened and continued is an administration fee and is not refundable. Requests for the refundable portion of a course fee must be made in writing, enclosing the pink receipt form, prior to the third regularly scheduled class. No refund will be made after this date, regardless of whether a student has attended a class or not. Please allow at least five weeks after the start of classes for processing and mailing of a refund cheque.

CANCELLATION OF CLASSES

Classes with insufficient registrations are subject to cancellation immediately following the registration nights. Students affected by a cancellation will be notified by mail or telephone and advised of other courses that are available.

CORRESPONDENCE COURSES

The Ontario Ministry of Education offers free courses to adults who are unable to attend day school. The program includes a wide range of subjects. ACTON NIGHT SCHOOL PROGRAM




