Public nurses, region talks resume

Public health nurses who have been without a contract for two years, will go back to the bargaining table with Halton Region around the end of September.

Sharon Campbell, president of Local 1, of Ontario Nurses Association (ONA) said the decision followed a strategy meeting Thursday.

"It's like starting at the beginning all over again, but

we have no other choice," Mrs. Campbell said.

The ONA has held several meetings to try and straighten the situation out with the province, yet, nurses are still living on 1975 wages.

Labor Minister Bette Stephenson, has been involved with the bargaining, but, Mrs. Campbell said, not one recommendation has come from her office.

"Perhaps, they think if they ignore us we will go away, but we won't," she declared.

Public health nurses are registered nurses who have chosen to work in the community, which requires extra courses, and earn \$12,075 annually while registered nurses earn about \$14,000 annually.

Although, public health nurses pay \$6 a month in dues to the ONA, Mrs. Campbell said,

nurses are not grumbling about paying the dues.

"It has been a long drawn out process, but, the ONA is not giving up and will keep plugging away until a contract settlement is agreed upon."

Nurses are complaining, however of their wages. These have remained the same for two years while prices have continually increased, she added.

"We are very anxious to get the contract settled," she said. It is not guaranteed that public health nurses will receive retroactive pay, but, she said, that is a condition that will have to be written into the contract.

In July a recommendation was handed down by the labor ministry saying public health nurses would have to live within economic restraints and

wouldn't receive retroactive contracts. It also said arbitration wouldn't be granted in existing disputes.

Public health nurses gear their efforts in the community towards preventive and teaching methods rather than a curative approach. Nurses work with senior citizens and enter homes within the community to offer help where needed.
