

Georgetown plant expands

A Georgetown plant has em- that it has become the only barked on a building program which will double its size by Dec. 1.

The expansion of Park Thermal Ltd., Todd Road, is the result of a move the firm took four years ago, said Brian

Dead are David G. Lyons, 49, of Moultrey Crescent, Georgetown, and Jack Schutten, 23, of Smithville.

Mrs. Shirley Lyons was admitted to the intensive care unit of West Lincoln Memorial Hospital Grimsby, with six broken ribs and internal injuries. A hospital spokesman listed her condition as stable and said she is "very comfortable as long as she doesn't move." They predict that she can be moved to a hospital nearer to

home "probably this week." The fatal accident occured at 11 p.m. on Sept. 21 on Highway 20 just east of the Grimsby Road. Police report that the eastbound vehicle driven by Mr. Schutten swerved into the path of the Lyons car, Mr. Lyons was killed instantly.


