Petition passed to police

A petition from residents of Weber Drive, Duncan Drive and Sinclair Street calling for stop signs, flashing amber lights and increased police patrols on the streets to reduce speeding and enforce existing stop signs was referred to the Halton Regional Police for comment Monday.

Weber and of flashing orange lights on both sides of this intersection to warn motorists that they are approaching a school crossing. They also suggest installing a three-way stop at the Duncan Drive and Moultrie Crescent intersection to control speeding on Duncan Drive.

They requested more police patrols between 3:30 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. during the school year as well as between 11 p.m. and 1 a.m. on Friday and Saturday nights. They also suggest the use of unmarked police cars in the area of the Weber Drive and Delrex Boulevard intersection and suggest that radar should also be used "periodically, preferably weekly" on Weber Drive.

Stop approved for Delrex, Edward

Works committee decided to advise council to install a four-way stop at the intersection of Delrex Boulevard and Edward Street, to lower the speed limit on Delrex to 40 kmh between Rexway Drive and Maple Avenue, and to look into the possibility of installing a sidewalk on the north side of Delrex from Edward Street to Maple Avenue.

The matter was brought before the committee because of complaints which Halton Regional Police receive of youngsters walking on the road instead of the sidewalk enroute to one of the three schools located adjacent to the Maple Avenue-Edward Street intersection.

The three recommendations which the committee passed were made by Police Superintendent F. N. Schwartz.

Committee decided against a fourth recommendation which was to put a crossing guard at the Edward Street-Delrex Boulevard intersection. The committee felt it was unnecessary.

Although town engineer Bob Austin felt that moving the stop sign from Delrex to Edward so that Delrex Boulevard would become a through street would handle the problem, he advised the committee that they should not move the stop sign now and later make it a four-way stop.

He said that vehicular traffic does not merit a four-way stop at that point as yet but pedestrian traffic might call for one if there was a survey done that would measure it.

Works committee chairman Mike Armstrong said he dislikes the idea of making Delrex a through street because he had "visions of traffic gathering speed at the bend on Carole Street and whooshing right through to Maple."

A sidewalk could not be put in on the affected section of Delrex until next year because it would have to be included in the annual budget, he said.
