Engineer to explain weed control

The responsibility for explaining the theory behind the town's weed spraying program to a group of dissatisfied citizens was left with town engineer Bob Austin by the works committee at Monday's meeting.

Members of the Limehouse Women's Institute wrote to the committee complaining of "indiscriminate killing" of vegetation along area roads.

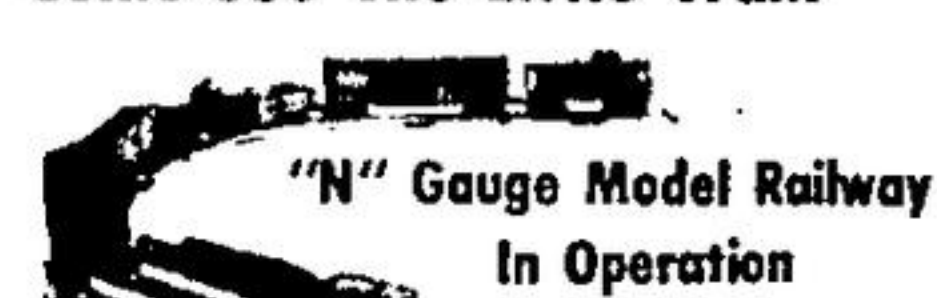
They claimed town sprayers destroyed useful vines, trees, and bushes as well as the weeds they were supposed to kill. It was the ladies' suggestion that each property owner be asked to cut the weeds on the side of the road in front of his property.

Coun. George Malby agreed with the women that spray can drift and cause unintentional damage.

Town engineer Bob Austin commented that a number of residents in the area have requested that the town refrain from spraying weeds on road allowances abutting their property and look after weed control themselves. He wishes that the ladies could have given more specific information as to when and where the damage occurred so that it could have been looked in to.

Mr. Austin felt that the vegetation is not being killed indiscriminately. The spraying is done to improve vision on roads, to keep down the bacteria count, to keep road allowances clean and to make snow plowing easier in winter, he said.
