Smoking affects nfants


Researchers at the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine studied the incidence of penumonia and bronchitis among thousands of children in their early years. They found that youngsters in the first year of life had a higher rate of these two diseases if their parents smoked. The rate was highest when both parents smoked, somewhat less when only one parent smoked, and lowest when both parents were

nonsmokers. Tiny lungs have trouble proecting themselves. Cigarette moke generated by parents' smoking actually doubted the risk of an infant's attack of pneumonia or bronchitis. "Atacks of pneumonia and bronchitis, particularly in the first ear of life," say the researchrs, "can still result in infant death despite prompt and vigorous treatment." The warnng is chilling.
