Shop wisely, read food labels

By Jan. 2, most New Year's resolutions are marked down for clearance to anyone in the market for damaged merchandise. One resolution, however, that every shopper should make, and can't really afford to break, in 1978, is to read food labels. It's the one relatively simple answer to shopping wisely; providing the best in the way of nutrition for yourself and your family, and checking the rising costs at the supermarket.

"Labels are the key," according to Marie LeClair, Area Director of Weight Watchers in Southern Ontario. "Being label conscious at the clothing store costs more. But at the supermarket, it's ignoring the labels that gets expensive, both to my health and my pocketbook."

To the uninitiated, reading labels sometimes seems like a full day's work. Fortunately, there are really only a few tips to understanding food labels and making them work for you.

The Food Research Department at Weight Watchers International is always sharing consumer information, in one form or another, with Weight Watchers members. Marie continues, "and I recently received the following label tips from members who are successful in my own shopping."

1. Even before comparing prices, compare products, notice not only the product and brand names, but also the style of packaging. Canned fruits can come in whole or in sections, for instance; tuna can be packed in water or oil. In particular, watch for descriptive words like "sugar added." Phrases like "juice drink" can also be clues to knowing you're not buying juice.

2. The listing of ingredients on a label is in the order of proportionate amounts by weight. This can be quite a revelation. It not only tells you what additives, and ingredients are in a product, but also whether there's more bread than veal in the pre-packaged cutlets on sale.

3. Knowing that by law, nutritional information must be on any product containing added nutrients, or making a nutritional claim, can give you a wonderful feeling of control. There is no way you can be fooled by all the psychologically packaged goods, once you know where and when to look for nutritional information for comparison. It's most often on the back or sides of packaging.

4. Once armed with the knowledge of what you are actually buying, you can then compare prices intelligently. Check amounts by net weight; where available, and don't rely on package size which can be deceptive. It's the net weight that tells you how much product, without package weight, you're getting. Remember, however, that it does include any liquid a food is packed with.
