





PARADE OF HOMES

Ontario Tapping, Keith Director for CMHC, Regional reviewed last year's housing activity in Ontario at a Press Conference held to mark the opening of a Central Mortgage and Housing Corporation lending office in Mississauga.

Mr. Tapping pointed out that, having regard to the uncertain economic conditions that persisted last year, 1977 had been a good year for house-building.

in 1977, preliminary data indicated that 70,168 housing-units had been built in urban centres in Ontario compared to 71,301 in the preceding year: this is a decline of only two per cent. Twenty-one thousand, five hundred and thirtytwo single detached dwellings were started last year, a decline of five per cent from the previous year's 22,617 detached units. Multiples were almost the same for both years with some 48,600 units being started in Ontario. Mr. Tapping estimated that Ontario's total starts for 1977 would exceed 80,000 units and be very close to last year's volume of 84,682. He attributed this relatively high volume of building activity to

the success of the Federal Government's Housing Action Program whereby 19,000 assisted rental loans had been committed last year by CMHC in Ontario. Only 4,585 such units were committed in 1976. Mr. Tapping also cited continuing support for the Assisted Homeownership Program which had resulted in some 12,763 units being approved last year. He mentioned that more than 60 per cent of all housing in Ontario was now being financed under the National Housing Act: most of this was being directed to meeting the needs of the more modest income groups.

Completions too last year were at a high rate and Mr. Tapping estimated that some 81,000 units were completed compared to 80,302 in 1976.

In addition to assisting the private sector to meet the needs for new housing for persons of moderate income, the Federal Government through Chc had committed some \$73.2 million for non-profit rental accommodation for low income groups together with \$41.5 million for co-operative, and \$52 million for public housing. In support of these

housing initiatives, to provide for the

orderly development and servicing of land to meet future housing requirements, CMHC last year committed \$31.5 million for the development of land acquired and \$89 million for sewage treatment facilities.

To conserve housing in neighbourhood improvement areas, CMHC available made rehabilitation loans amounting to \$14.4 million.

Mr. Tapping said that in order to improve even further its services to the public, the Corporation had established a major lending office in Mississauga with Mr. J. Warren Sanderson as Manager. This action recognizes the Halton and Peel Regions as the fastest urban growth centres in Canada.

Mr. Tapping estimated that last year some 10,600 housing-units had been started in that area, more than half of which were row and apartment units. He anticipated that this level of activity would continue next year despite economic uncertainties and that even higher rates of housing activity would be needed to meet the burgeoning growth that is predicted for this area in the next decade.
