CVCA issues flood warning

The Credit Valley Conservation Authority (CVCA) was warned this week to expect heavier than normal spring flooding on the Credit River watershed this year.

The warning, from the provincial natural resources ministry, follows tests by the ministry's conservation authorities branch on snow conditions at Terra Cotta, Belfountain and Monora Conservation Areas.

The lests revealed that the snow water content in excess of 150 per cent of normal exists on parts of the Credit watershed and soil moisture content is still high as a result of heavy rainfall last fall.

The CVCA has produced a flood warning manual to assist its staff in alerting local municipal officials and media to possible flooding.

A sudden thaw could cause problems in the Glen Williams. Meadowvale and Churchville areas as well as all streams and creeks running to Lake Ontario through Mississauga and any area where ice is blocked like bridges and culverts, CVCA official say.

CVCA officials said the ministry's warning does not mean there will necessarily be flooding this year.
