Firemen's meeting held

Georgetown firefighters hosted the quarterly meeting of the Ontario Firefighters Association for the first time Sunday afternoon.

Georgetown has not hosted a meeting before because of a lack of the facilities necessary to accommodate the number of people who attend the meetings. Over 200 people attended on Sunday representing 57 fire departments.

The general meeting during the afternoon consisted of a presentation of training films by a representative of Pinwheel Productions of Acton, and discussions of a number of issues relating to firefighting, such as the new lens for amber lights on the firefighters' own vehicles, which will make the lights brighter. The annual convention, being held in Aurora on Aug. 4 this year was also discussed.

Energy centre opens

Halton Hills will have a new outlet for information on energy conservation when a federally-funded community conservation centre opens in the Georgetown Market next Monday.

Coin collection stolen

A quantity of European, Canadian and American coins were stolen from the home of a Georgetown resident last week. The home was broken into some time during the late afternoon or evening on Feb. 19. Entry was gained by a side door. The burglars escaped with European coins, Canadian silver dollars, American silver dollars and an American \$50 bill.

Limehouse school opened in 1962 and reached a peak enrollment of 240 students in 1966-67. Grade 7 and 8 students were removed from the school when Stewarttown senior school opened in 1967 but Limehouse got its first Kindergarten class that same year. Its present enrollment is 196.

This is expected to fall to 180 by September.

Limehouse has a special education teacher conducting classes in the building each morning and shares a remedial teacher with Gibbons school.

Speyside school opened in 1960 and reached a peak enrollment of almost 300 students in 1969. Its present enrollment of 170 students is expected to drop to 158 by September.

Little school in the west end of Acton opened in 1952. It reached a peak enrollment of almost 800 in 1976. Its present enrollment of 467 is expected to remain steady next September.

Don Gentleman, superintendent for the north area, attributes much of the anxiety expressed by Speyside and Limehouse parents to misinformation and the fact that the principal's report suggested twinning for schools with declining enrollments as a way of prolonging the life of these schools.

He says that twinning between Gibbons and Limehouse will result in the two schools sharing a librarian and a principal. Little and Speyside schools will share a librarian and a principal if they are twinned. Little will also lose its vice-principal, but since this was set to happen anyway twinning will not effect the situation.

To the editor of The Herald: This is to comment on the letter to the CBC about their TV program on newspaper carriers (The Herald, March 1).

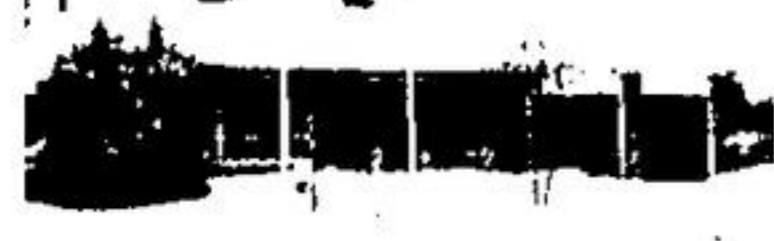

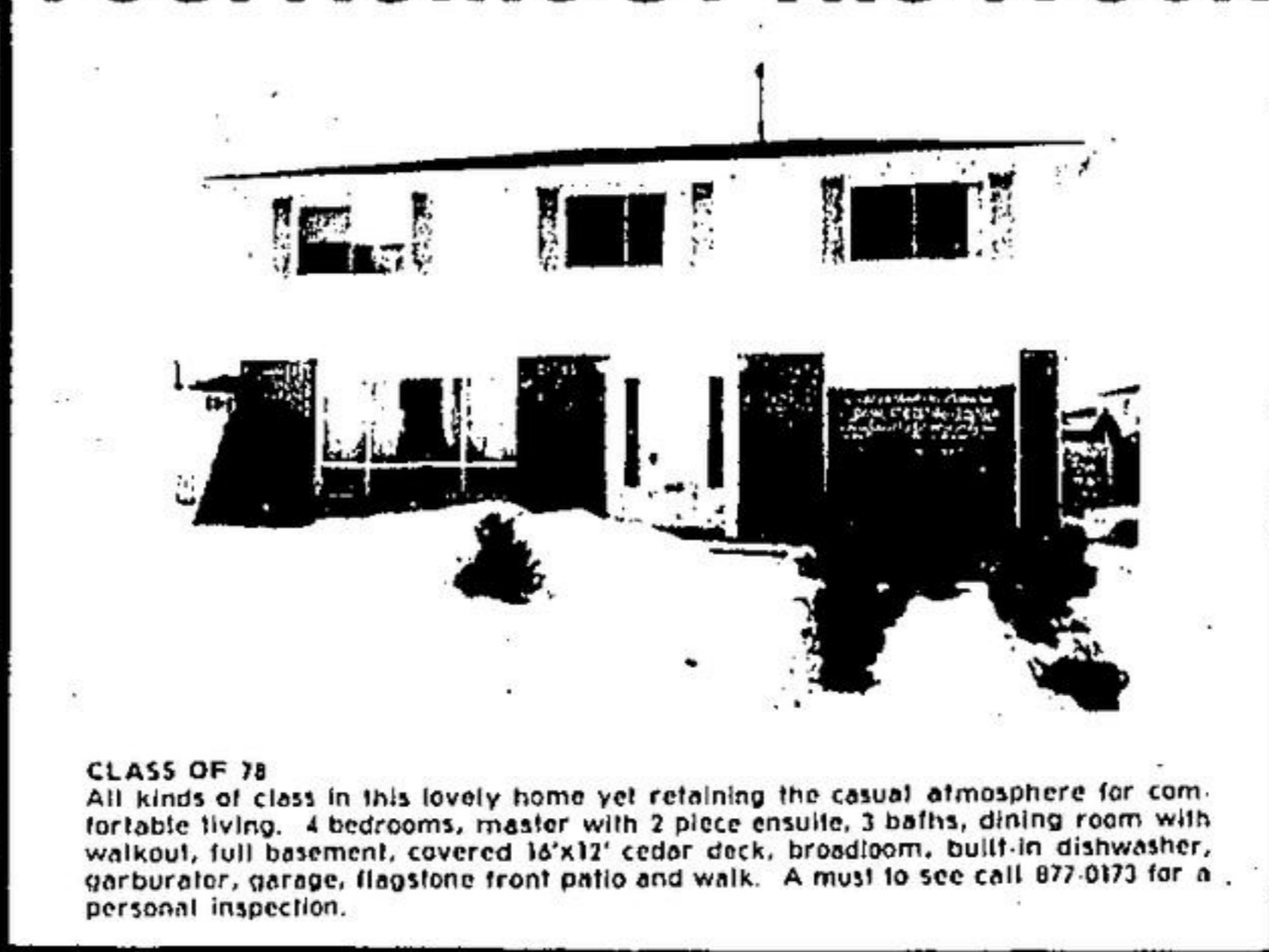
