are pregnant. Dostoevsky's involvement with his wife's first pregnancy was so intense that he couldn't write for the first six months vel the idea he conceived during this period eventually gew into one of his greatest novels.

Suzanne Arms' Immaculate Deception was written to delineate "the American way of birth." She is concerned that so many women who gave birth in hospitals recount "incident after incident of loneliness, fear, frustration, humiliation, loss, and a deep and guilt-ridden belief that they have missed the most profound experience of their lives."

Arms sees the history of childbirth as a "chronicle" of interferences in the natural process." For the small number of women who have complicatins giving birth, the obstetricaian's scientific skill must be "legitimately respected and preserved."

However, the doctor often forces the majority of women to undergo "procedures that are unnecessary for all but a few," for the sake of routine and predictability.

This "preventive" care carries its own risks to both mother and baby. Pitocin, for example commonly used to stimulate contractions, increases the risks of post-partum hemorrh-

At least half of the book discusses alternatives to the routine hospital story -- training for natural childbirth; pressing for more sympathetic hospital surroundings and standing up for one's need and wishes; the litereasing popularity of home births; the return of the midwife.

Both books make fine reading not only for expectant couples, but for anyone who has mothered or fathered a The experience of giving

birth is a central event in one's life one that is difficult to assimilate and come to terms with. These books enable one to re-live and re-evaluate the extraordinary experience. They also give heartening


