## Area youth fined \$150 in snowmobile accident

Paul Leonard Mercer, 16, pleaded guilty to charges of careless driving under the Snowmobile Act, driving a snowmobile without a permit prominently displayed, failing to produce evidence of insurance within the required period of time, and driving a snowmobile across a highway without being in possession of an operator's licence.

An earlier charge o criminal negligence resulting in death was withdrawn at the request of the crown attorney. Mr. Mercer pleaded guilty to

Mr. Mercer received a fine of \$100 on the charge of careless driving, a line of \$50 on the charge of failing to


### Region probes ravine erosion




