'Sandy' Best

Former Halton MP Alexander "Sandy" Best died of a heart attack March 29, and his father, Dr. Charles H. Best, who collapsed hours after hearing of the death of his son, died late last week.

Alexander Best, 46, died suddenly at Sunnyside Hospital in Toronto. He is survived by five children: Charles, Alexander, Margaret, Melinda and Susan.

Mr. Best was a resident of Esqueping Township. He was the son of Dr. Best and Margaret Mahon Best. Other surviving relatives are his brother, Henry Bruce MacLeod Best, president of the Laurentian University in Sudbury, and his aunt, Linda Mahon.

Mr. Best was born in Toronto July 7, 1931. He and the former Eileen Jane Thompson were married on June 6, 1958. Mr. Best won Halton riding for the Progressive Conservatives in 1957 with a majority of 7,500 votes. In the 1962 election, he was defeated by 98 votes. Mr. Best described himself as a nurseryman and scientist. He ran Greenock Farms in Georgetown.

Mr. Best's father, Dr. Charles Herbert Best, was world known for the work he did in the development of insulin, which saved countless lives from diabetes. Dr. Best worked with the late Sir Frederick Banting at the University of Toronto. Banting was killed in a plane crash in Newfoundland during the Second World War, while being flown to Britain on a secret wartime research project.

CAS, Glen histories soon

A history of the Children's Aid Society in Halton, written by Rev. Richard Huggles of Glen Williams, is expected to be available this month (April).

Rev. Huggles, a former CAS director, said he worked on the 32-page book about a year during his spare time. He expects the book will cost about \$2.50 with the proceeds going for the printing.

The CAS in Halton was the last one to be formed in Ontario in 1914. He said he enjoyed the research into the early files of the society.

Rev. Huggles said his next writing project is an address in May as president of Canadian Society of Church History. After that, he expects to wrap up a history of Glen Williams by the fall. "It's almost all written," he said.
