Media conference at Sheridan

Sheridan College is holding a conference on The Effective Use of Media in the Health Services May 30 at the Ontario Hospital Association Headquarters in Toronto.

The event brings together organizations, individuals and institutions involved in developing effective media systems and materials for use in hospitals and related health service agencies.

During the one-day conference pharmaceutical and medical supply houses, producers and distributors of media will meet and interact with health service personnel, educators, audio visual systems managers, administrators and resource and library staff.

The conference grew out of a research project conducted by the Media Arts Department at Sheridan which included an extensive survey of media use within the province's health service community.

The results of the studies and the conclusions reached by participants at a similar conference held last November pointed out several inefficiencies in the use of the material currently available in the hospitals.

Whether produced in house, commercially or with government or industry support, materials have not been fully utilized. As a result, institutions are obliged to develop more sophisticated production capabilities of their own.

Oakville college has highest registration

A recent part-time enrollment report issued by the Ministry of Colleges and Universities shows Sheridan College with the highest student registration in the province as of February 1978.

During the period from November 1, 1977 to until February 1, 1978, 16,823 part-time students were registered in credit and non-credit courses offered through the Community Services Division which provides studies in continuing education, retraining and training and leadership development.

The provincial total for all 22 community colleges was 136,789 for the same period.

"Included in the 16,823 figures were those students finishing 60-hour courses they began in the fall," said Dean of Community Services Don Hamilton.

In a breakdown by program area, the report shows Sheridan led the way with 1,364 students registered in training and leadership development (formerly called management development and training). This figure represents about one-third of the provincial total.

In the short program category which accounts mainly for clerical and academic upgrading, Sheridan had the largest enrollment of 923 students.

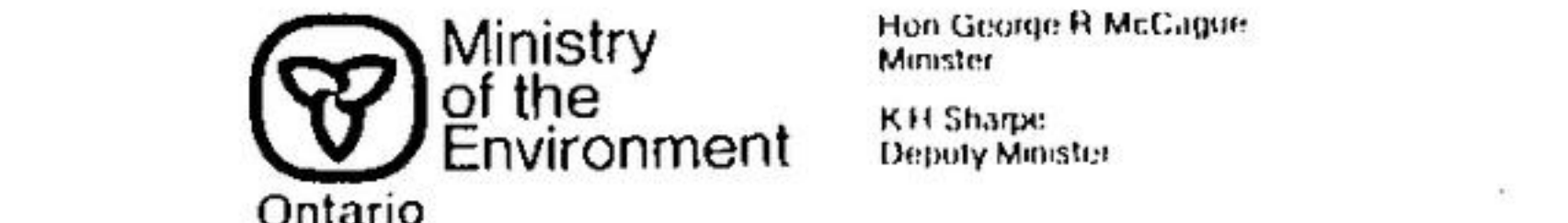
Post-secondary extension courses also had the highest registration with 8,649 students while Sheridan ranked third highest in the area of general interest with 3,262 out of a provincial total of 33,203.

Although final statistics have not been compiled for the fiscal year, Hamilton estimates that 35,000 students will have completed part-time courses at the college between April 1977 and March 1978.

The Community Services Division provides fall, winter and spring-summer program sessions at on and off campus locations in Halton and Peel
