To shop at the bontique, craft shop or duty-free shop you have to step out of the hotel lobby and around the driveway. If you want to play golf, the hotel is planning a free golf day a week where transportation, membership and green fees are all complimentary. The only thing that would be charged to your room would be long distance telephone calls.

Couples is an excitingly different sort of place to go on holiday. If it were just another inclusive holiday resort it would be very good. But it's more than that with a special atmosphere encendered by the couples and the staff. Couples really is the sort of place you'd dream of taking a loved one, or of being taken by someone you're particularly fond of. Couples is one of those rare places that consistently and delightfully exceeds your expectations whether in the quality and presentation of the food or the happy, social ambience that exists.
