Robin Lowrie who portrayed the Lilliputian king was equally convincing as a bigot and a tyrant.

The cast did a fine job of producing a good group effort where no one stands out as a star and everyone shared the credit for a well-rounded show.

The primary and junior choirs who will be competing in the music festival in Acton today sang their festival pieces and the ukulele group also performed to round out the school's spring concert.
