Construction of transmission towers from Bruce Nuclear generating station to the switching station at Milton is proceeding in all parts of the corridor except Halton Hills.

Peter Webster, community relations officer for Ontario Hydro, declined to estimate Monday just when the 170-fool towers would be going up in a 250 foot wide corridor down the middle of the Fifth Concession.

In light of an Ontario Municipal Board (OMB) hearing scheduled July 31 at which Ontario Hydro will appeal a Halton Hills denial of an official plan amendment and rezoning to permit tower construction, the decision of the OMB and possible appeal to the Ontario cabinet on the decision no estimate of when the line will be completed was made.

"All these things are a little unpredictable," he said.


