Towers under construction

Construction of transmission towers from Bruce Nuclear generating station to the switching station at Milton is proceeding in all parts of the corridor except Halton Hills. Peter Webster, community relations officer for Ontario Hydro, declined to estimate Monday just when the 170-foot towers would be going up in a 250-foot wide corridor down the middle of the Fifth Concession. In light of an Ontario Municipal Board (OMB) hearing scheduled July 31 at which Ontario Hydro will appeal a Halton Hills denial of an official plan amendment and rezoning to permit tower construction, the decision of the OMB and possible appeal to the Ontario cabinet on the decision no estimate of when the line will be completed was made. "All these things are a little unpredictable," he said. But work on other parts of the \$86 million (1976 dollars) line is proceeding, he said. In the 16 mile (25.7 km) section from the generating station to Bradley Junction, the towers are almost all strung, he said. In the section from Bradley Junction to Colbeck, a distance

of about 51 miles (82.7 km) and where the right of way is 180 feet wide only one foundation out of 483 remained to be installed and about 100 towers to be erected, he said. Stringing of the towers in this section should be done by the end of the summer.

In the section from Colbeck to Limehouse, 27.75 miles or 44.7 km, 35 foundations are left to put in and work is going on now on tower erection, Mr. Webster said. Out of 183 towers 120 are going up.

In the Limehouse to Milton route, nothing is going on but for soil testing and the collection of preliminary engineering

data. About 84 towers are up but none of course in Halton Hills.
