Red tape slows opening of Norval man's business

The red-taping effects of red tape were again the topic of debate at last Tuesday's town planning board meeting as Hugh McFarlane of Norval sought permission to operate a real estate office and an antique and gift shop out of his Highway 7 home.

The board attempted to expedite the matter by simultaneously approving the request and asking planning director Mario Venditti to prepare a report on the proposal.

A preliminary report noted that there are more than 10 other commercial outlets within a block of Mr. McFarlane's home, ample parking space at the rear and a major arterial road at the front.

"It is believed (the proposed real estate office) may advance the town's interest in attracting industry to the area," the report added.

In accordance with the official plan for the former township of Esquesing, permission was granted to Mr. McFarlane to use up to 25 per cent of the floor space on each floor for his intended commercial purposes. Plans call for a 180-square foot real estate office at the rear of the building and a 500-square foot antique and gift shop at the front.

Councillors George Malby, Pat Patterson and Pat McKenzie promptly asked for approval to be granted immediately. "I get tired of all this red tape," Coun. McKenzie commented. "We get so tied up with things, we can't say 'yes' when a man comes in with a straight, honest request."

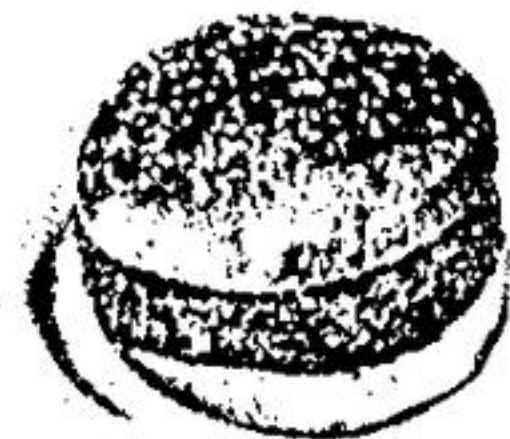
Mr. Venditti explained that certain factors have yet to be documented, particularly since Mr. McFarlane was un-

able to supply a site plan of his lot. The site plan must be included in the necessary by-law, he said.

"It's those fellows in Queen's Park who set the rules for the

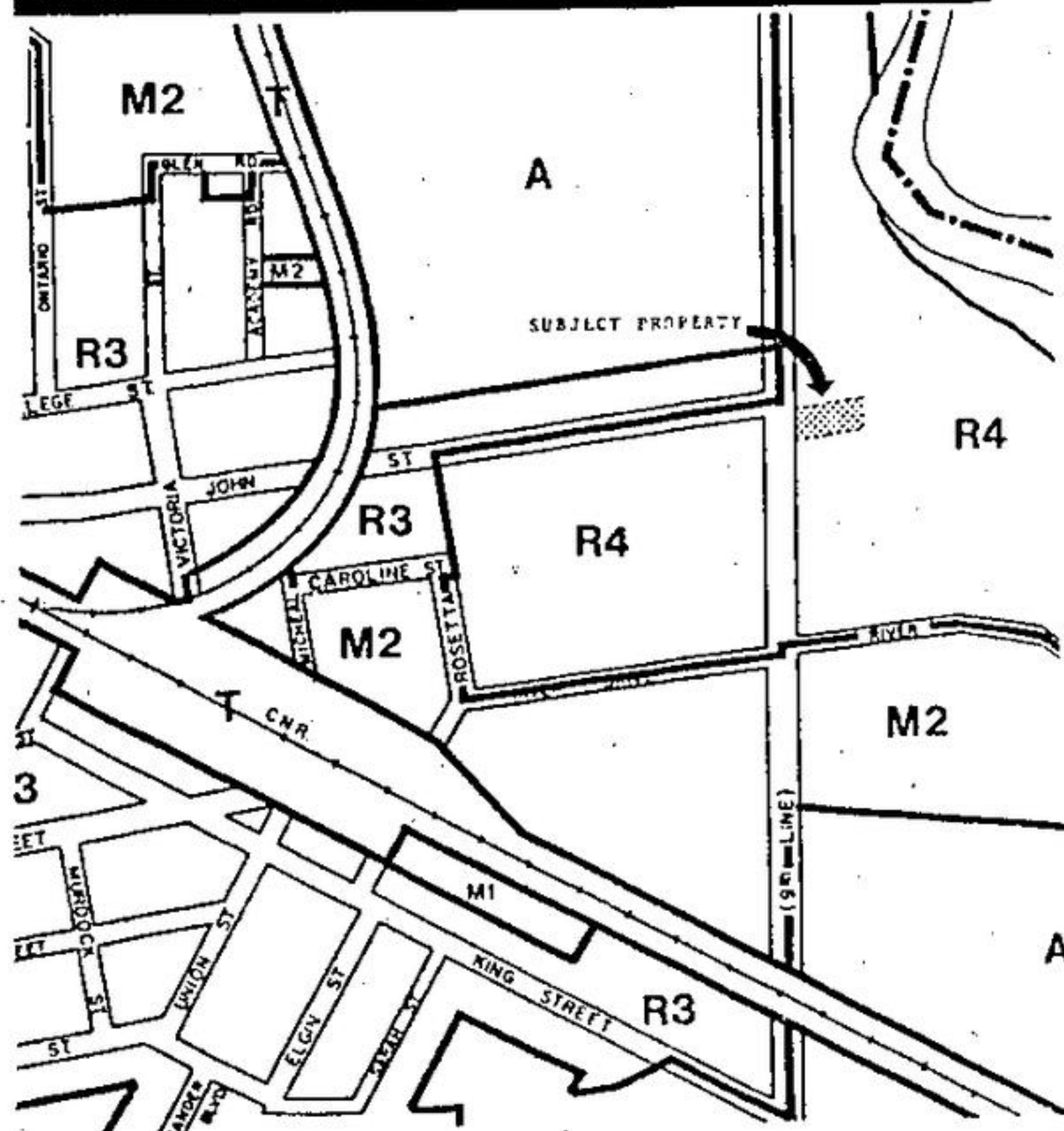
planning of a municipality," Mayor Tom Hill observed. "But for something like this, I think we should try and get it pushed through as fast as we can."
