## Action creates more problems

Town council's handling of appeals by Acton residents to close up an unused road allowance off Elmore Drive contin-

ues to create new problems. Mayor Tom Hill informed council Monday night that he has been contacted by residents of the west Acton neighborhood who are upset about the administration committee's efforts thus far to meet the wishes of George Van Der Eyken, whose Elmore Drive property abuts the road allowance.

Because of the public reaction the board's decision to try and close off the easement. thus shutting out noisy dirt bikes and dune buggies, will be reconsidered. Mayor Hill asked to have all affected residents notified of an upcoming committee meeting.

Coun. Roy Booth pointed out that Mr. Van Der Eyken's request could be accommodated without delay and without having to involve his neighbors but other council members voted to try and settle all related problems at the same

Coun. Mike Armstrong recalled that works committee members viewed the location four years ago on a roads tour, and the problems have not changed since.

Residents are complaining about youngsters using the road allowance as an access route to a large sand dune at the rear which dirt bikers and others have found to be an ideal racing site. Police are invariably too late to catch the noise-makers when residents contact them, Coun. Booth explained.

## New street lights approved

New street lights may be installed along Maple Avenue in Georgetown between Guelph Street and the new District 2 firehall if the necessary funds can be made avail-

Council Monday night agreed to have town engineer Bob Austin examine his department's budget to see if at least \$1.945 is available to install new lights between the firehall and Mountainview Road.

The Georgetown Hydroelectric Commission quoted the cost for council and added that another \$4,344 could see the section of Maple Avenue between Mountainview and Guelph Street illuminated at the same time.
