A new ski rental booth was built over the summer and additional skis have been purchased for rental. Area facilities include a concession booth where hot food and drinks are available, and a warm-up area with movies and slide programs on some weekends.

The conservation area will be open daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. during the Christmas holiday week, except for Christmas Day and New Year's Day. After the holidays, the program will continue each weekend from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., depending on the weather.
