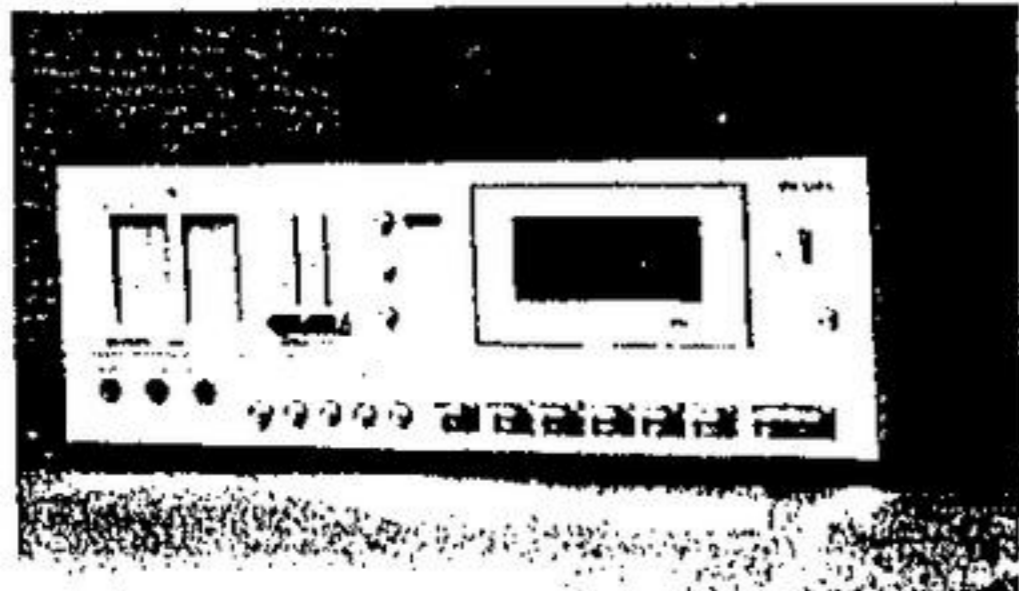

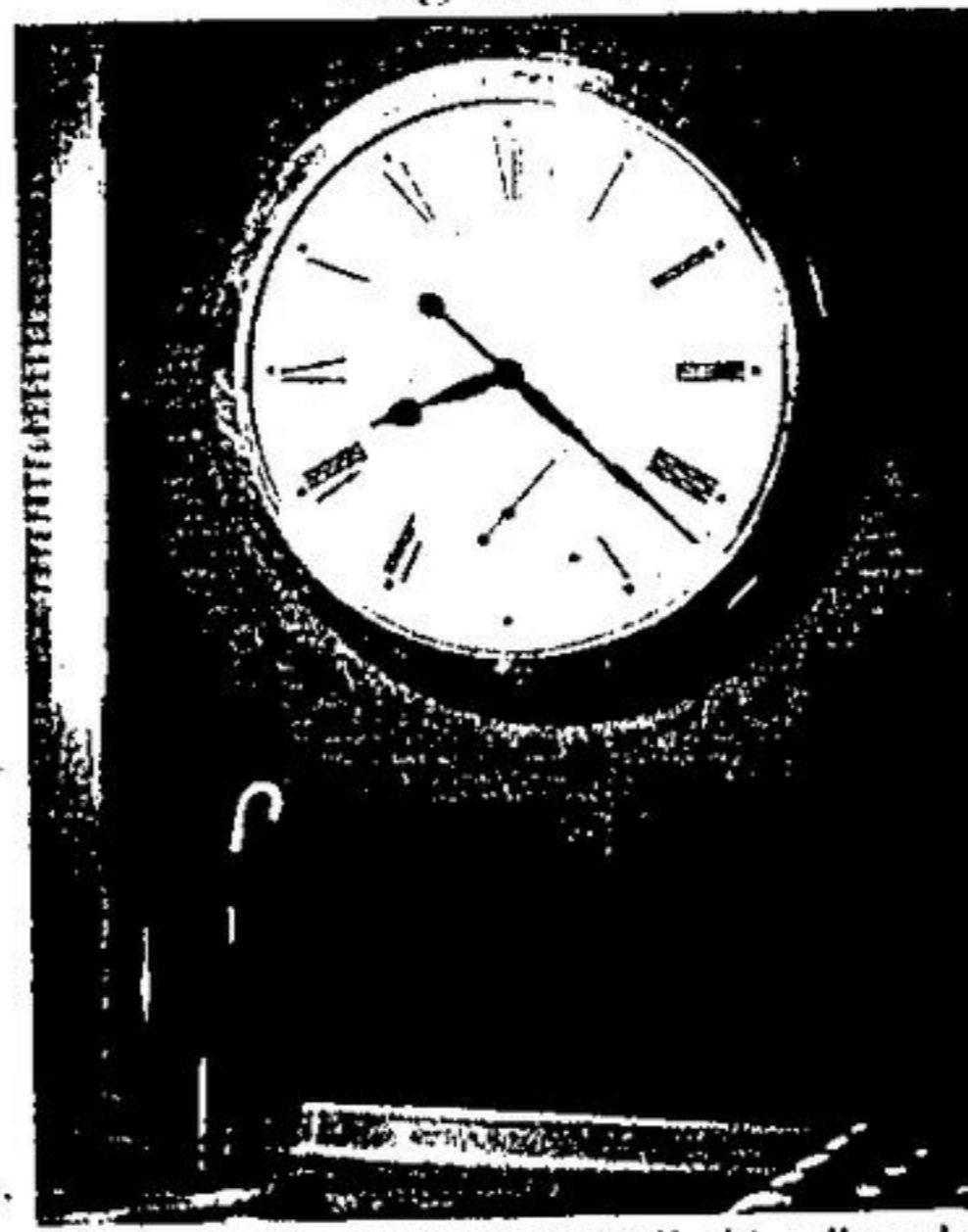

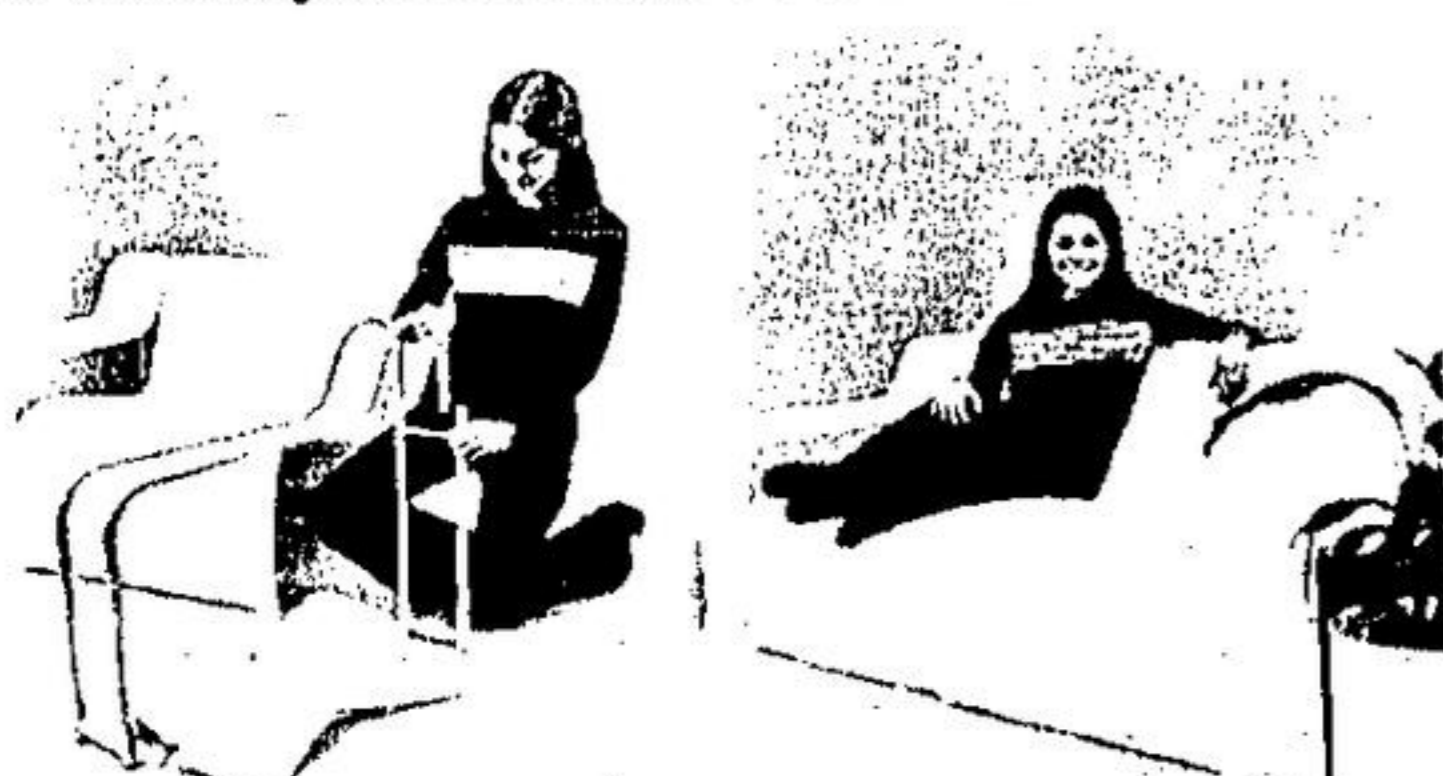
The appeal of these handsome wallcoverings is enhanced by the hand printed
