The GDHS wrestling Rebels continued their winning ways by taking top honors at a tournament in Ottawa over the weekend. The meet was held at J.S. Woodsworth in the nation's capital.

Four Rebels won in individual categories as Georgetown claimed a second victory over powerful Smith Falls. They had also defeated them at the Rebel Invitational.

"Smith Falls will be tough by the time OFSAA rolls around," said coach Bob McKay. "They had a few injuries and they always peak for OFSAA."

The four Rebels winning their divisions were Chuck Anderson at 84 pounds, Jim Wittmeier at 90.5, Frank Miedzinski at 112 and Peter Fournier at 127.

Wittmeier's victory surprised McKay as the grade nine student never wrestled be-, fore this year.

"Jim has just come out of the woodwork," the coach said. "He has been the most pleasant surprise on this year's team so far."

McKay said Miedzinski was excellent in winning his division.

"Frank beat Mike Payette, one of the toughest competitors, 1-0 in a great match," McKay said. "Frank will be very tough at OFSAA."

Fournier the defending OFSAA champ at 114 wrestled for the last time this season at 127. From now on he will be at 119.

McKay said that Fournier had no problems handling the bigger wrestlers at Ottawa.

"No one came close to touching Peter up there," McKay said. "He'll be awfully tough to handle at 119, but anyone can beat."

Joe Ibuki had another excellent meet finishing second at 119. He'll wrestle at 112 the rest of the season.

Kevin Brown finished second at 141 pounds with his only loss coming to Claude Daoust, a two-time defending OFSAA champion.
