Travel Village London

LONDON - Not one vast city, but a series of inter-connected villages, each with its own character and local attractions - that's the way I describe London to folks who have never been here. Unfortunately, most tourists hug too close to the hub of Piccadilly Circus to see the London I am talking about.
 But as the throng of visitors swells each year, the temptation to get out into the local neighborhoods once you have covered the main sights, becomes not only more appealing but downright practical. This season, London Transport has even organized its own off-beat tour of the back streets of London complete with a late night beer-and-buffet feast served on a barge cruising down a north London canal. Tickets are about \$15 for the day tour and meals. (Details from London Transport or the Tourist Information Centre at Piccadilly Circus.)
 "We wanted to offer the tourists something offbeat, something different from the normal milk run of Buckingham Palace and the Tower this year," Maureen Gaythwaite, London Transport's tours manager who thought up the village route.
 If you would prefer to save the ticket price and see the villages at your own pace, number 3 or 53 doubledecker bus from Piccadilly Circus (ride upstairs for the view) or the tube, will take you north to Camden Town in less than twenty minutes. This now trendy north London village with its refurbished

town houses, local Greek inhabitants, bookshops, open-air market and inexpensive boutiques is also a short walk from the London Zoo in Regent's Park.
 At lunch or dinner the informal and very authentic family-operated Greek taverna in Bayham Street (one block east of Camden High Street) are worth trying. MODITS and ANDY'S are the names to remember. In Parkway the street which leads into Camden Town from Regent's Park the Primrose Cafe has kept its genuine working man's cafe atmosphere since the turn of the century. Tea is dispensed from an antique canteen urn by the cashier and the basic bar appetizing menu is chips

with everything.
 The BLACK CAT PUB in Camden High Street is famous for its Friday night drag shows (adies welcome) and a new dinner-cabaret, MADISON'S at Camden Lock has been attracting as

many celebrities in the audience as on stage since Margaret Trudeau paid a surprise visit on opening night.
 A number 24 bus, or the tube, will take you north from Camden Town to Hampstead, favorite London vill-

age for artists, actors and the idle rich. Many of the locals come from the Continent and their liking for convivial public meeting places is reflected in the pubs, cafes, tea-rooms and bistros. The best coffee and pastries are served at LOUIS, a proper German-style KONDITOREI, in Heath Street. For a sample of what the fashionable Hampstead girls are wearing this season, look in at the local chic boutiques:
 ASPARAGUS, BAZAAR, CROCODILE, and VILLAGE 8.
 Hampstead borders on north London's loveliest, unspoiled oasis of parkland known as Hampstead Heath. While the public footpaths may seem to be luring you into the wilds, almost any one of them on the south face of the Heath will lead you in a north easterly direction to the neighboring village of Highgate, about two miles away. Highgate is famous for its 17-century pubs and quaint village high street. Dickens once had a house here and Karl Marx is buried in Highgate cemetery now surrounded by a lovely park off the high street. The local pubs to visit are the GATE, the Bull, the WRESTLERS and the FLASK, said to have been a favorite watering hole for the infamous Dick Turpin in olden days.
