Love-in' greets Trudeau at Brampton stop

Prime Minister Pierre Trudeau, who has faced heckling over his marital problems and other matters during the current federal election cam--paign, came to Brampton Thursday and found a love-in waiting.

. The crowd was estimated at between 1,000 to 2,500 people on hand at Shoppers' World to greet Trudeau and hear him speak on behalf of Liberal

candidate Ross Milne. Hecklers and hostile placards were conspicuously absent, and Trudeau's Tory-bashing campaign

speech drew repeated cheers and applause.

NEARLY CRUSHED The 650-seat Shoppers Cinema was nearly filled 45 minutes before Trudeau's scheduled noon arrival, and when he turned up, 15 minutes late, he and Mr. Milne were nearly crushed in the overflow crowd as they made their way slowly into the theatre.

Mr. Trudeau smiled happily during the 10-minute slog into the theatre, even when an NDP campaign pamphlet was handed to him. A teenager asked him what the main issue in the election was, and he responded, "the issue, my friend, is

Dwelling mainly on energy, but touching also on multiculturalism, deficit financing and the Quebec controversy, Mr. Trudeau painted Progressive Conservative leader Joe Clark as a man who cannot make the difficult and sometimes unpopular decisions which are necessary for the good of Canada as a whole.

Mr. Trudeau said Mr. Clark has "copped-out" on the issue of oil price policy, because if Clark made a clear policy statement on the issue, he'd
