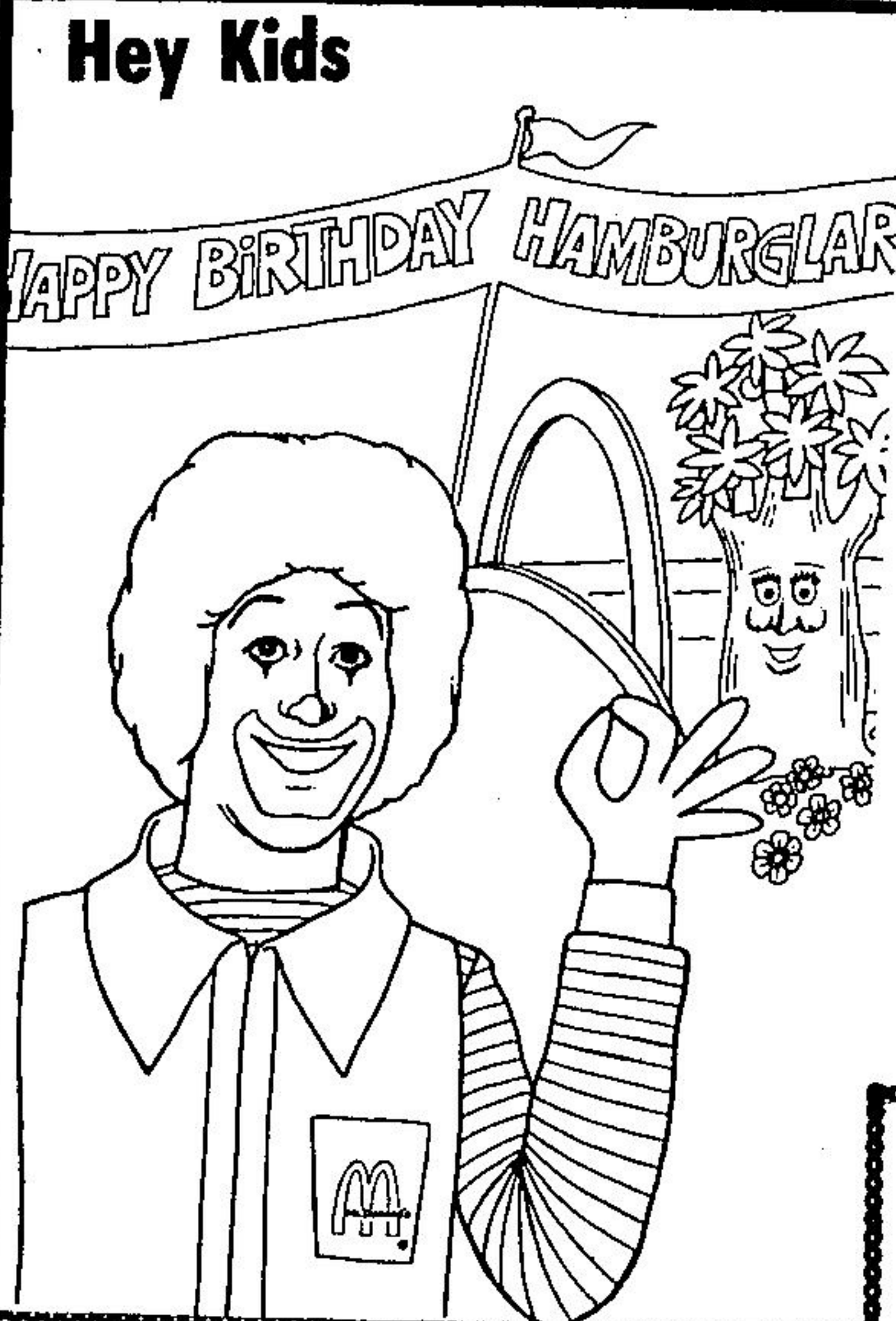
In the first game the Labelmasters went up against Fort Erie and ended up on the short end of a 4-1 score.
