

Timmins set to host Intermediates

A hassle between the Canadian Amateur Hockey Association and the local people running the Eastern Canadian Championships in Timmins has been resolved and the hockey tournament will get underway in that northern city tonight.

The Georgetown Raiders, champions of the Ontario Hockey Association, boarded a bus last night and they will see their first action tonight.

There will be six teams competing for the right to play the western champions for the Hardy Cup.

SIX TEAMS

The teams in the tournament are the Raiders, the Timmins North Stars (qualifying as the host club), Charlottetown G.T.s (Prince Edward Island champ), Kirkland Lake Blue Devils (Ontario Northern Hockey Association winners), the Carol Lakers (Newfoundland's best) and the Moncton Bears, who went all the way in New Brunswick.

Late last week it was feared the tournament would not be staged as a result of a battle between the local people putting on the tournament and the Canadian Amateur Hockey Association officials.

The dispute centred around money which the locals thought the AHA had promised them to stage the tournament. In any event the differences between the two groups have been resolved and the tourney will go.

Heather Campbell, sports writer with the Timmins Daily Press, has researched all the teams which qualified for the tournament and is calling for a final between the Raiders and the Blue Devils.

Campbell said that the Moncton Bears do not look as strong as previous representatives from the powerful New Brunswick league. Perennial champions in New Brunswick, the Campbellton Tigers, were defeated by the Bears.

As for the host team, Campbell said they have a strong netminder in Jim Young, a former pro manning the nets, but after that they are thin. Young is the only former pro in the lineup.

LOOK OUT

A team to look out for is Kirkland Lake. Campbell said they have a fabulous skating club. They finished first as well as taking the playoff crown up north.

Charlottetown and Carol should not give any of the big clubs many problems.

The six teams will be broken into two divisions with two from each of the division qualifying for the semi-finals.

The Raiders will be in group A, which will include Timmins and Charlottetown. Moncton, Kirkland Lake and Carol will be in the B divisions.

Being in A division the Raiders, unless the northern air gets to them, are guaranteed a spot in the semi-final.

The first place team from "A" division will meet the second place team from "B" in one semi. The first place team from "B" would meet the second place finisher in "A" in the other.

Unless a surprise happens Georgetown should be battling either Moncton or Kirkland Lake in the final. The other good possibility is those two teams meeting in the final.

Georgetown's first game will be tonight at 9 p.m. when they faceoff against Timmins.

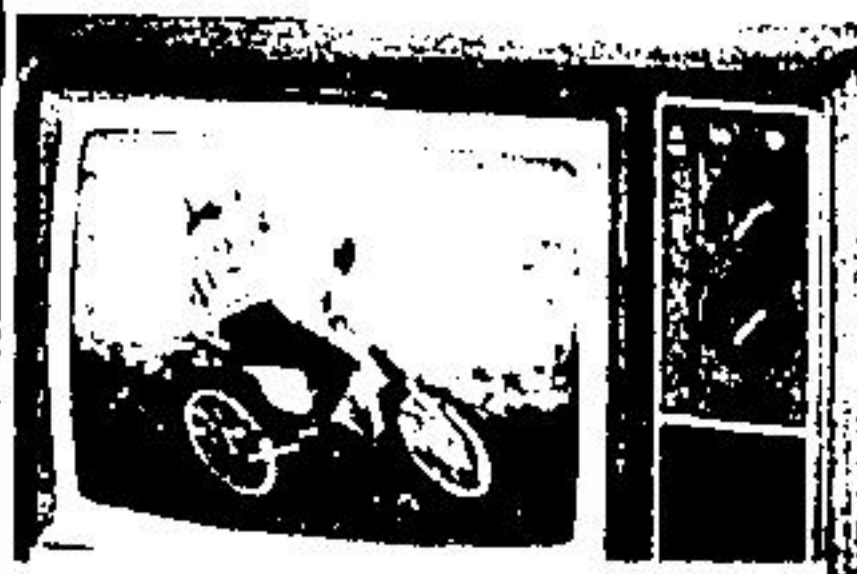
