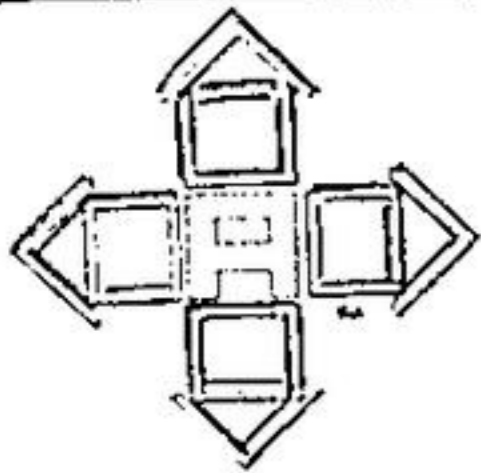

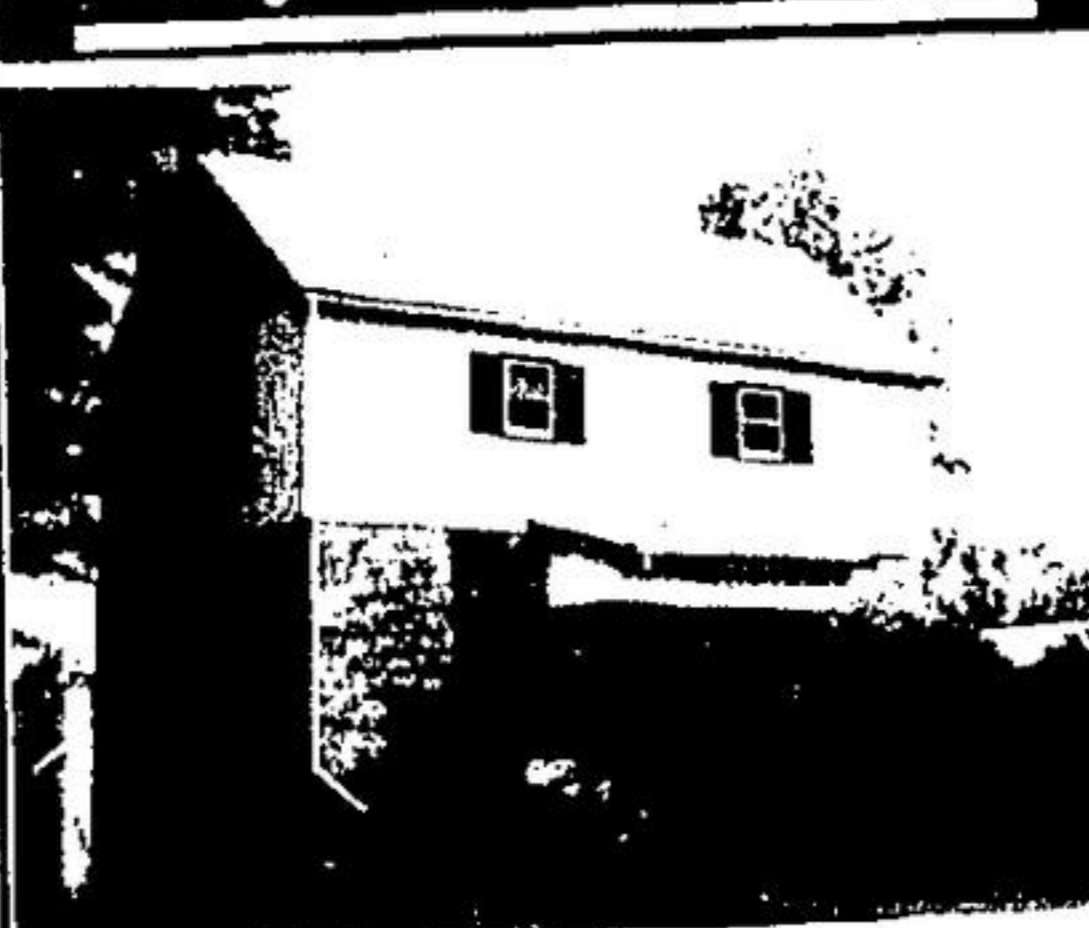

**Halton Swine Club visits Swine Research Centre**

How many days from breeding until a sow farrow? What types of feed do pigs gain the fastest weight with? And do pigs do better in a barn or in a natural outside environment?

All of these things and more are what the Arkell Swine Research Centre in Guelph are trying to find out. The Halton 4-H Swine Club had the pleasure of visiting this Centre at the last meeting on Tuesday, May 1st. After reciting the 4-H Pledge, the members were required to put on boots and overalls, supplied by Arkell. Being the last one to receive overalls, my knees were at my feet, since the overalls were ten times too big. Our guide was Tom Park who works at Arkell and is also one of our club leaders.

The members learned many interesting facts about pigs. One of them is that pigs are very thick skinned. Even though pigs have very little hair to keep them warm, they can survive Canadian winters almost better than Canadians themselves can. Some pigs never know the cosy comfort of stall inside a barn.

Pigs are also very strong. Just think, if they don't like the feed they are receiving, they just throw the feeders in the air with their noses. By the way, some feeders can be more than 100 lb. heavy.

Crabgrass can be a troublesome weed in August if it is not attacked in the spring. Because crabgrass is an annual weed, germinating in the early spring, it is often not recognized until brown patches show up in the late summer. Crabgrass can be controlled by pre-emergence herbicides but can be controlled much more satisfactorily by good cultural practices. A well-fertilized lawn mowed at 1 1/2-2 inches, will keep crabgrass under control.

Crabgrass does not like shade so it can be smothered out with a thick, lush lawn. However, if there was crabgrass in the lawn last summer it will soon be germinating and chemical weed control must be applied before germination. Crabgrass herbicide is incorporated in some fertilizers, which can save you a trip over the lawn. Check the label to see if the active ingredient is present.

Bensulide (Betasan), Chlor-thal (Daethal), Siduron (Toppersan), and Terbutol (Azak) are all herbicides on the recommended list for crabgrass control.

Since the percentage of active chemical differs in the various commercial products, follow manufacturer's directions and cautions on the label.

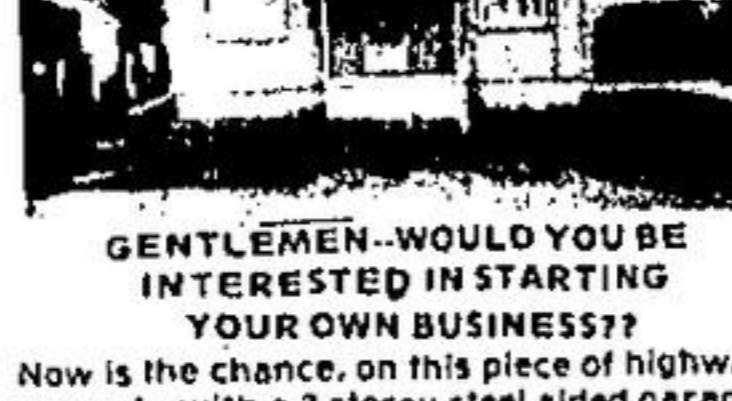

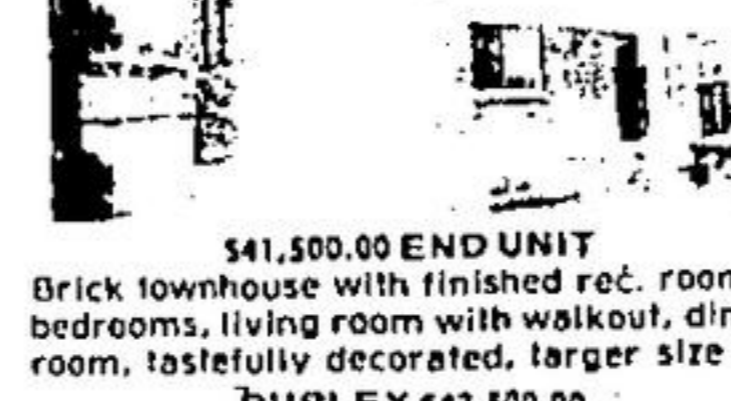
